Volunteers are an important part of why our Osher program is so successful. Please consider volunteering in one of three ways: on our executive committee, as a council member, or a committee member. You will benefit by developing lasting bonds with other members and knowing that your contributions make a positive impact on the program, and are deeply appreciated.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE (Five elected volunteers serving staggered 2-year terms)

President

Osher's official university representative who leads the institute and creates a sense of community and connection for all members. Presides over council and executive committee meetings, plans the agenda, implements the decisions of the council and communicates them to the membership.

Vice President of Planning

Plans the program activities and events of the institute. Works closely with the curriculum committee and activities committee chairs to ensure proper scheduling and support. Responsible for directing Osher's community outreach programs to increase program visibility in the San Diego and UC San Diego community.

Vice President of Administration

Oversees the work of the program office and its needs. Coordinates the institute's long-range schedule, electronic voting, member surveys and managing the Osher email lists in the absence of the Program Manager. Acts as a liaison with university departments to promote volunteer opportunities for Osher members: i.e. participating in studies, working with the International Center as tutors and similar opportunities.

Secretary

Takes the minutes at council meetings (kept in the Institute office) and assures that changes in policies and procedures are recorded in the manual. Also keeps notes at executive committee meetings.

Treasurer

Prepares the annual budget (with the President, Program Manager, and the UC San Diego Extension Program Director) for submission to the executive committee and then to the council for review and approval. With the President and approval of the council, reviews and recommends expenditures and income of assets invested in the UC San Diego Foundation and the Office of the President (UCOP). Prepares quarterly financial reports (with the Program Manager) on operating receipts and expenditures using UC San Diego's financial system.

COUNCIL MEMBERS (Five elected positions each year serving 3-year terms each)

• The council is composed of fifteen members with oversight of the Osher program. It receives reports and votes on all matters of importance along with the five elected officers and immediate Past-President. It is responsible for ensuring effective governance of fiscally sound programs as well as strategic direction of the organization.

COMMITTEE DESCRIPTIONS (Chairs are non-elected positions with no term limits and may determine the size of their committees)

Marketing Committee

Develops and executes a marketing plan for the year with the Program Manager.

• Membership Committee

Helps build the Osher community through membership recruitment and retention efforts.

Curriculum Committee

Facilitates the planning of Osher classes and activities every quarter of the year.

• Live Music Committee

Selects and hires musicians with assistance of curriculum committee.

• Theatre World Chair

Selects productions and casts performances each quarter in coordination with Theatre World Directors.

Events Committee Chair

Plans and executes all off-campus trips and activities away from Osher.

Open House Chair

Plans and executes two Open Houses per year with the goal of recruiting new members.

Happy Hour Chair

Plans and hosts Happy Hours with input by executive committee.

• Fundraising Committee Chair

Sets and achieves a fundraising goal every fiscal year with the Program Manager.
