REQUIRED MATERIALS:

- Basic Drawing Materials (we won't be studying figure drawing costume sketching is a tool to portray your ideas on paper)
 - Drawing pencils (could be your 2HB basic yellow pencil) & sharpener
 - Drawing paper of your choice (printer paper or a cheap sketchbook)
 - Eraser (to erase pencil marks)

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- 1" 3 ring binder
- Glue stick & scotch tape
- General Purpose Scissors
- A journal or notebook for taking notes
- Various Craft materials on hand (glue, markers, found magazines for collaging ideas, etc.)
- Access to a printer for printed digital work if you are comfortable illustrating your ideas on Photoshop
- Sewing Machine Every student must have a sewing machine. If you do not have one and would like to rent one for in-class use, they are available for \$10 per class. Let the instructor know as soon as possible as machines are limited. Bring your machine manual with you to each class.
- All purpose thread –Gutermann and Mettler are preferred over Coats and Clark's /Dual Duty. Contrasting for samples, matching for projects.
- Pins (glass head)
- Sewing machine needles Universal Schmetz 80 (brand will be discussed in class according to student sewing machine)
- Hand sewing needles assorted pack
- Bobbins for your machine.
- Tape Measure (60" reversible, non-stretch, 5/8 inch wide)
- Shears (Scissors) for Cutting Fabric (buy a good quality shear at least 6 -7 inches). It is important to purchase a good quality sheer/fabric cutting scissor.
- Band-Aids
- Seam Ripper
- Fabric Marking Pen/Chalk/Tracing Wheel & Paper
- Small paper bag/gift bag for your fabric scraps for your workplace
- Container for Supplies (Tools kit/Clear Plastic Container carried in a suitcase on wheels.)
- Project supplies
 - Bandana tote bag
 - 2 bandanas

- Coordinating thread
- 1½ yd cord 9/32" wide
- Apron
 - Pattern Simplicity 4282
 - Fabric 1 ½ yard cotton woven fabric
 - Coordinating thread
 - Trims/embellishments of your choice (will be discussed in class)
- Hat
 - Pattern instructor will provide
 - Supplies will be discussed in class.
