Academic Writing

Mastering Your Public Speaking Skills

By practicing how to solve specific speech problems, such as speaking too quickly, too softly, or too indecisively, you will identify your own weaknesses and learn how to use various strategies to become a more articulate, confident, and successful speaker.

Pronunciation and Fluency

By the end of the class, you will have gained awareness of your problem sounds, learned how to produce those sounds accurately, and understood how to continue refining your speech while strengthening overall confidence.
