Most students in need of financial assistance receive private loans or apply for a certificate payment plan (plans available to Paralegal Full-time students only).

PRIVATE LENDER LOANS

Students may qualify to receive loans from UC Approved Lenders. The complete loan process takes approximately 3 weeks to complete. Students are also encouraged to contact their own bank or credit union for possible lending solutions.

UNEMPLOYED STUDENTS
