Osher features twice-daily lectures and seminars by the outstanding faculty and researchers of UC San Diego and the entire San Diego academic community, as well as local leaders, artists, and musicians. Class topics include Medicine, Science, Law and Society, History, Art and Humanities, International Relations, Literature, and Social Sciences. Informed member-led discussions of current events, member luncheons, and field trips enhance the Osher experience at UC San Diego.

During the upcoming quarter most on-campus classes will be simultaneously live-streamed via Zoom. By enrolling in an Annual, Quarterly, or Monthly membership, you will have access to LIVE lectures every day. Members can attend all scheduled classes or pick and choose the courses that fit their individual schedules. An Online Affiliate Membership will give you access to the video recordings of our lectures from this quarter and those recorded previously, but does not include participation in our daily program.
