

INDUCTION CANDIDATE AND MENTOR COURSE ALIGNMENT

Throughout the duration of the <u>Induction program</u>, the Site-Based Mentor is required to complete corresponding Induction Mentor training and support courses at the same time their Induction Candidate completes the Induction courses. The Induction Site-Based Mentor will need to enroll into the respective Mentor course section with the same start and end dates as their Induction Candidate's course. Candidates may have additional required courses per their Planned Course of Study that do not have corresponding coursework for their Mentor.
