




#### **Diamond District Population**






#### Age Distribution








#### Citizenship Status of Foreign Born








#### Household (HH) Income Distribution






















#### Percent of 12th Grade Students Taking the SAT











#### Percent of Resident vs Incoming Students (2013-14)



#### Graduates with Postsecondary Enrollment 1-Year Post Graduation









### Health Insurance Coverage by Source











### Immunization Status of Kindergarten Students




### **Body Composition of 9th Graders**



# Percent of Population Residing more than 1 mile from Grocery Store






