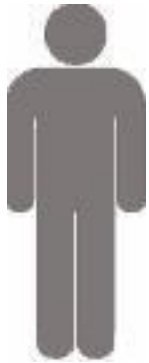

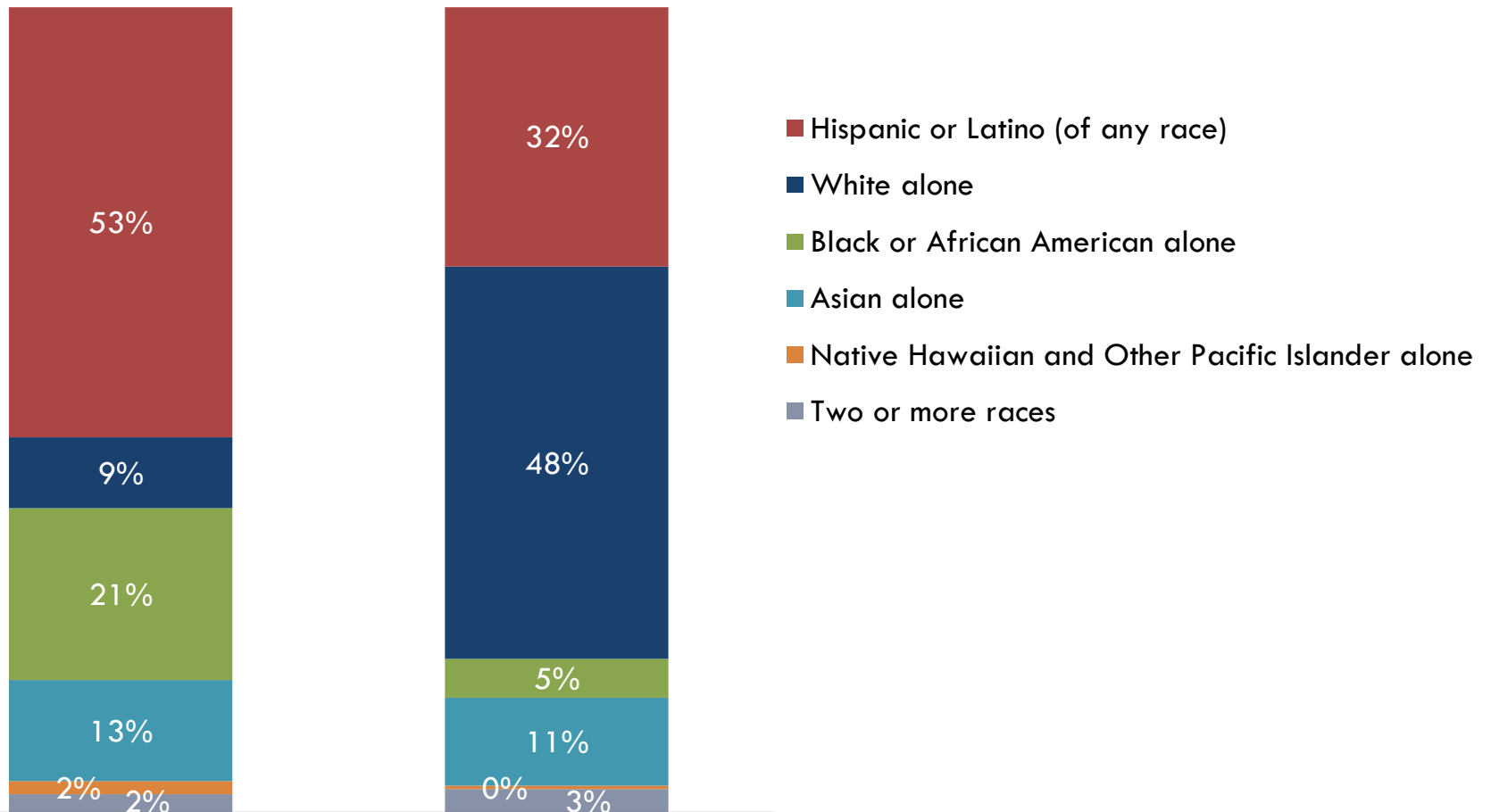

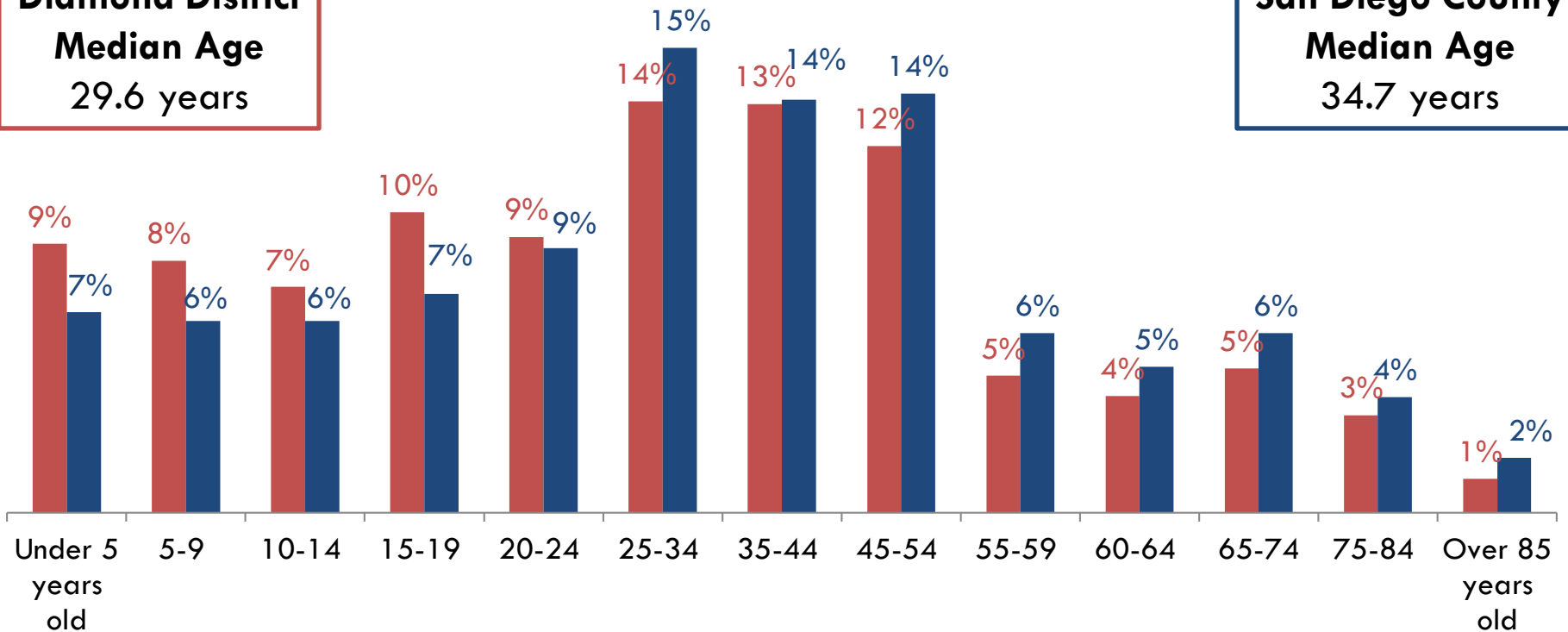

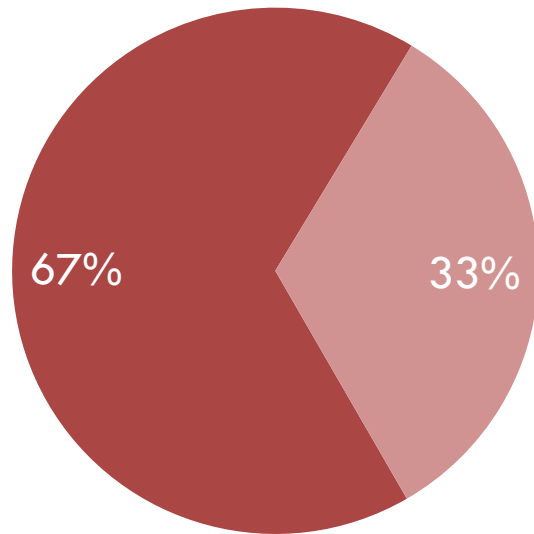

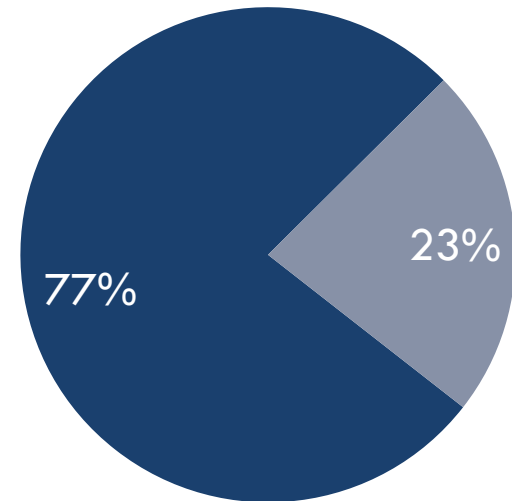

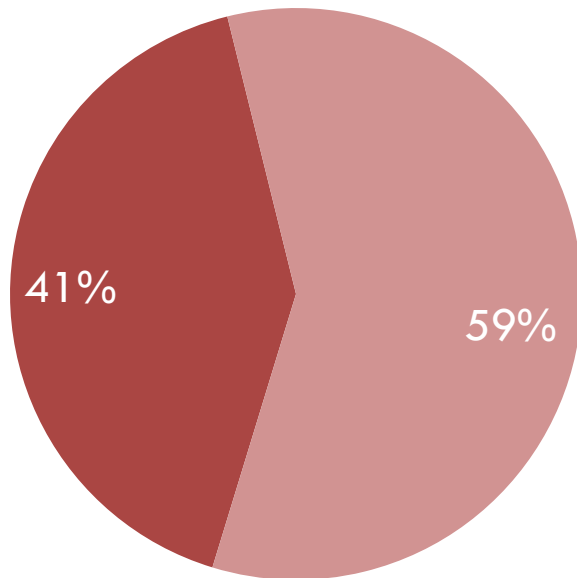

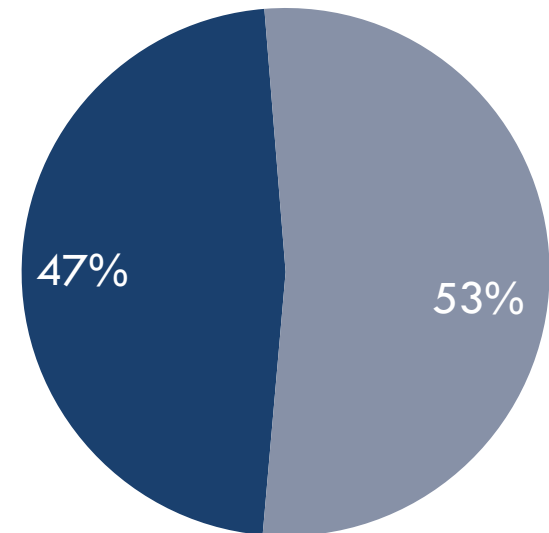
Citizenship Status of Foreign Born

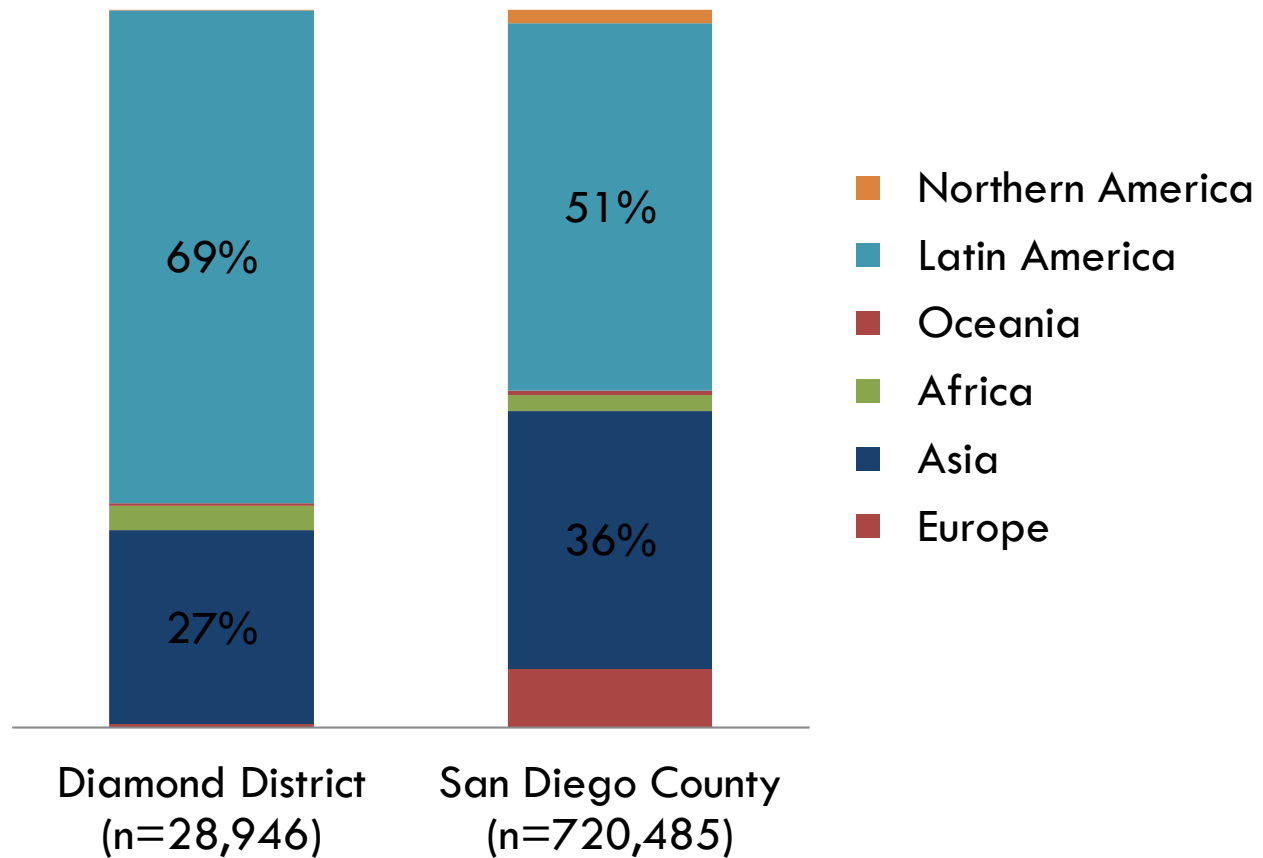

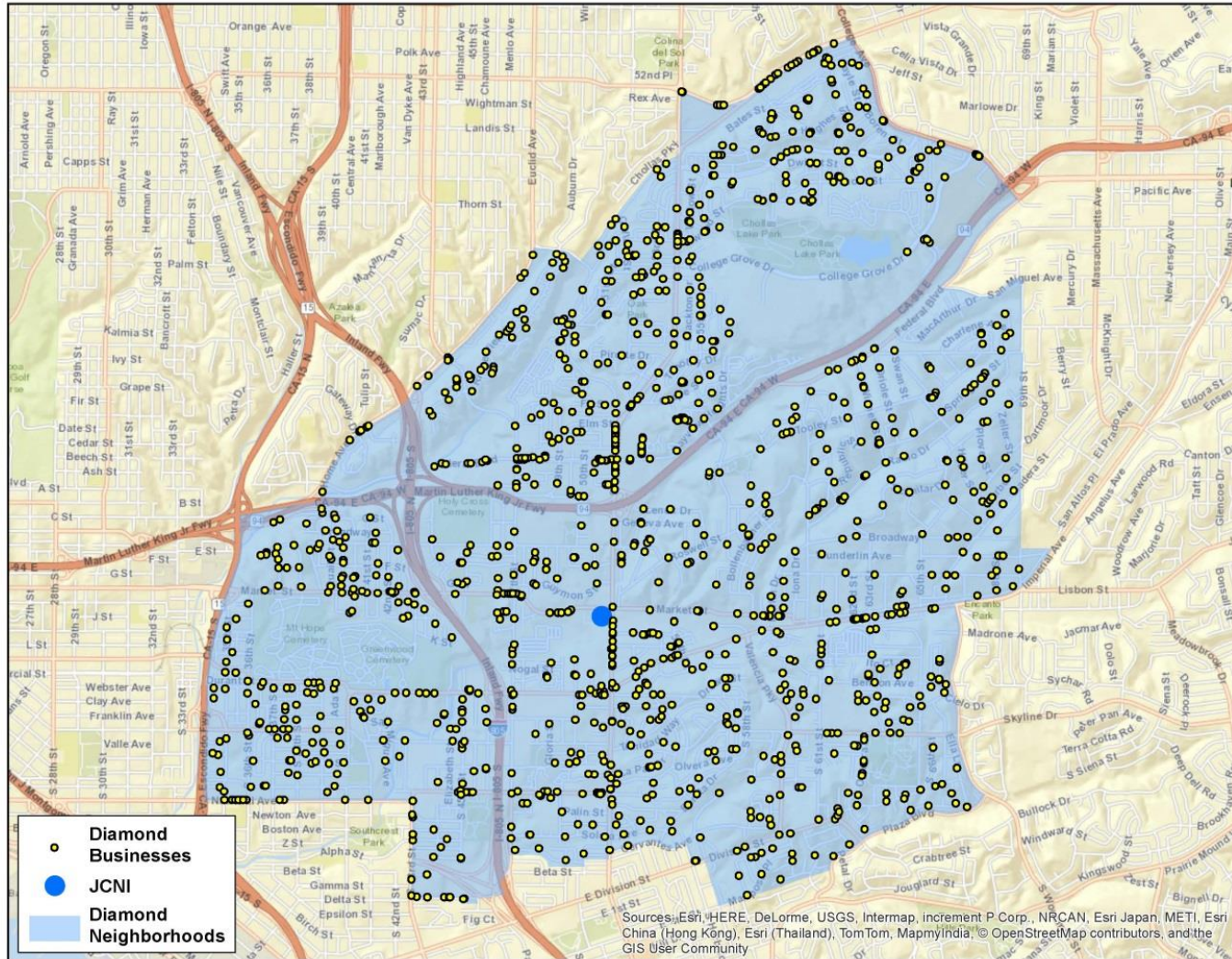

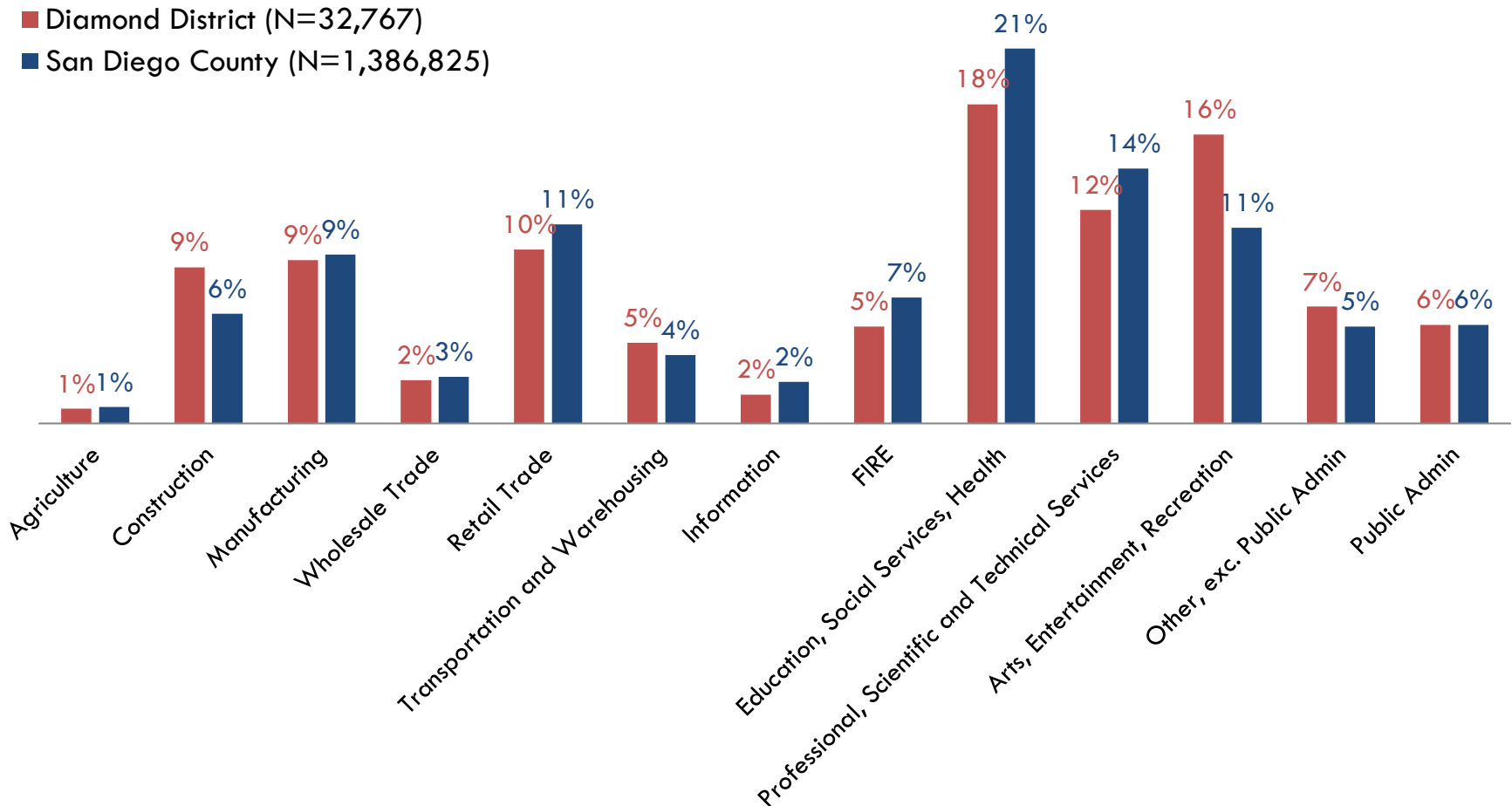

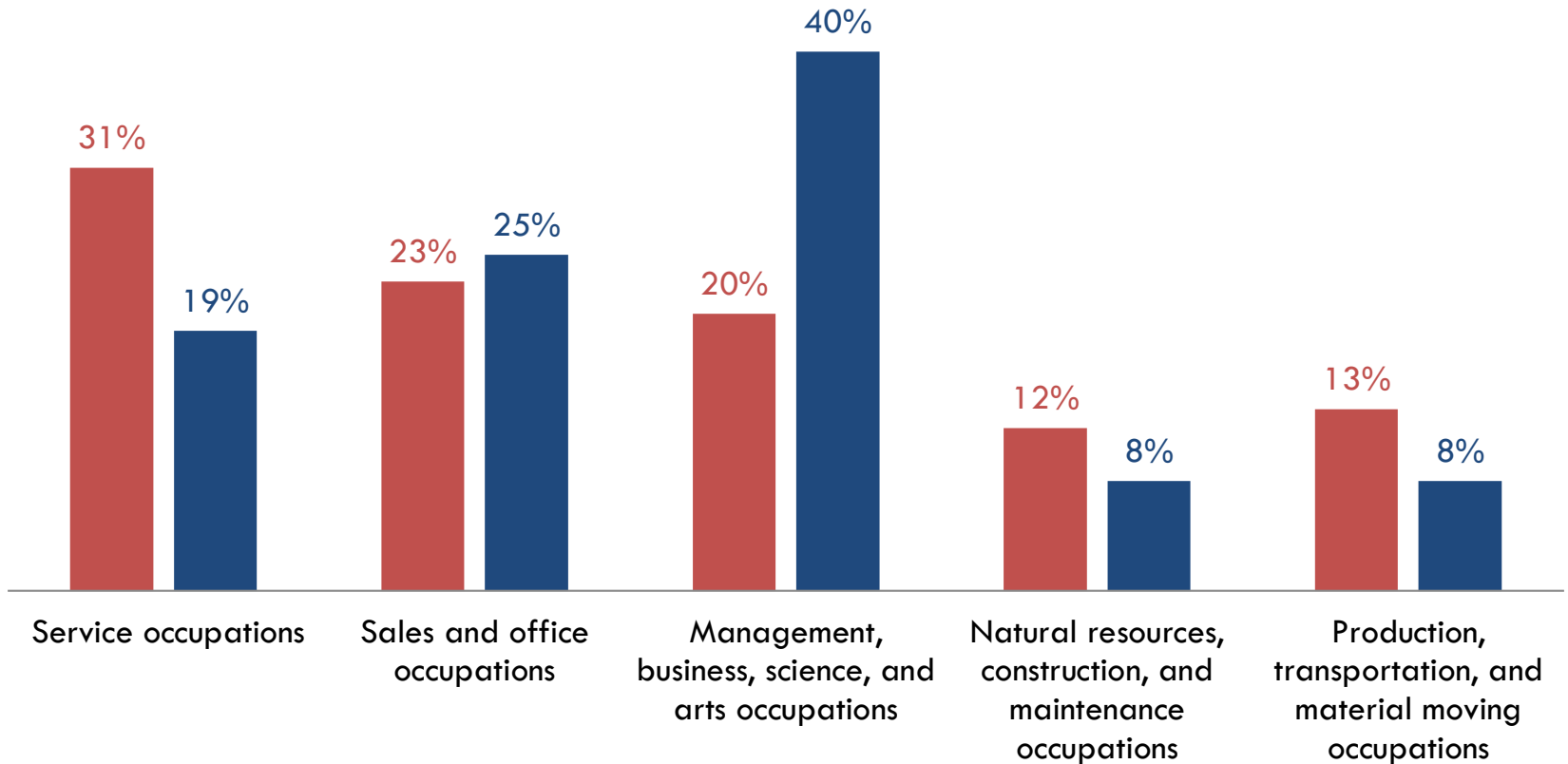
Employment by Industry

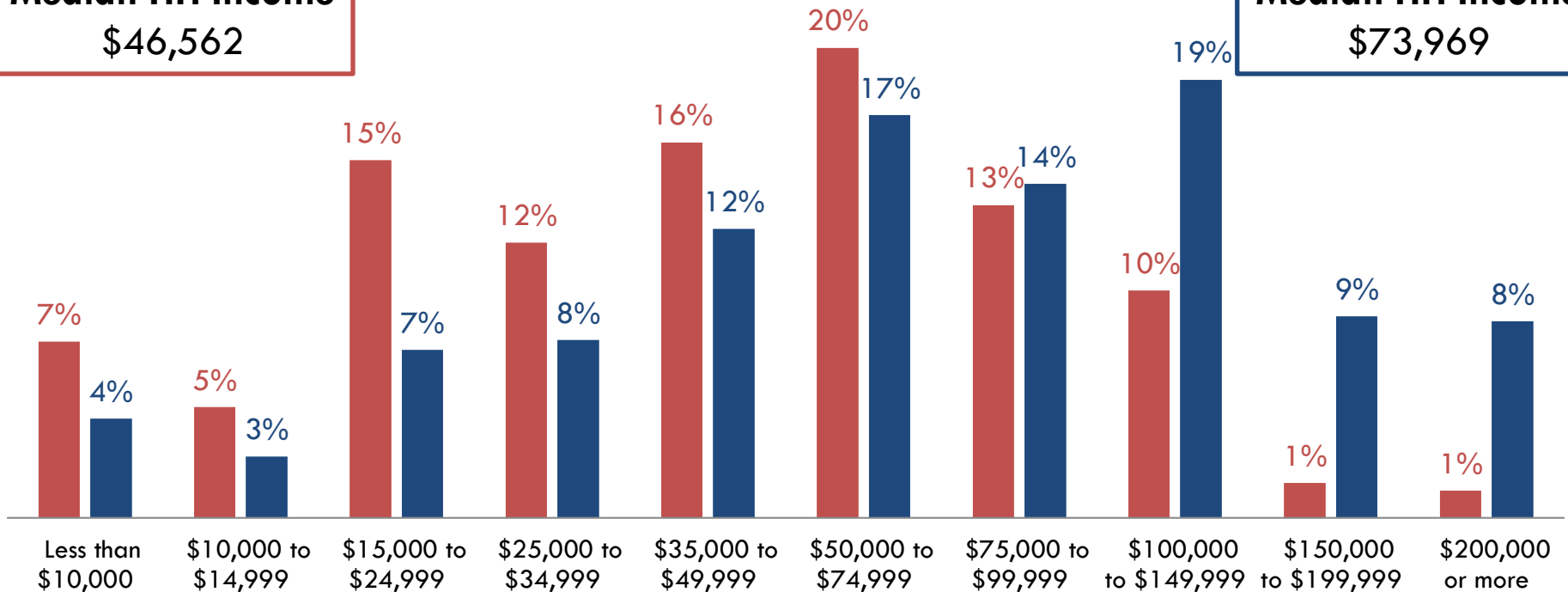

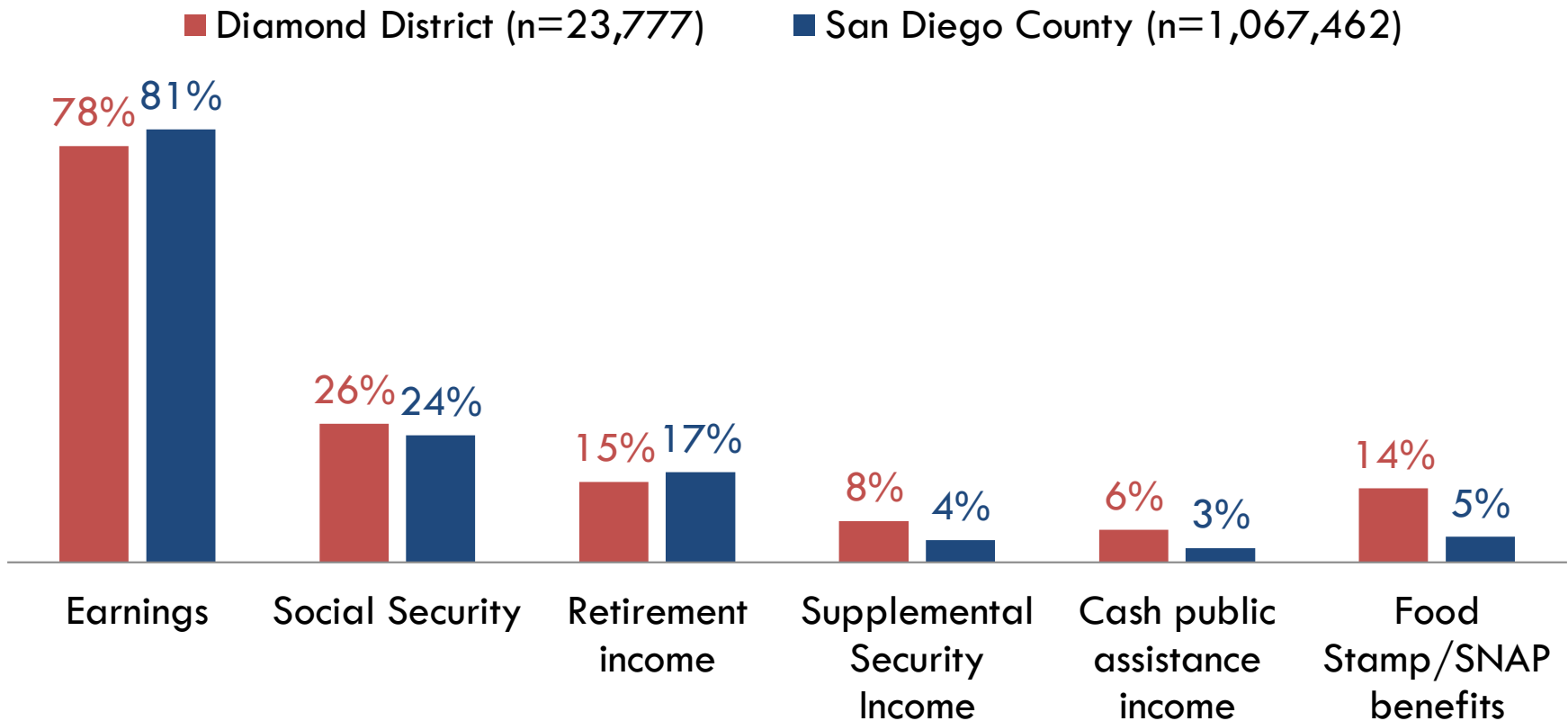

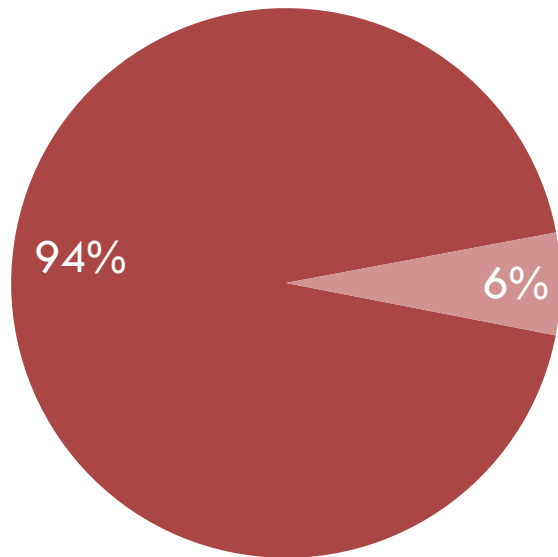

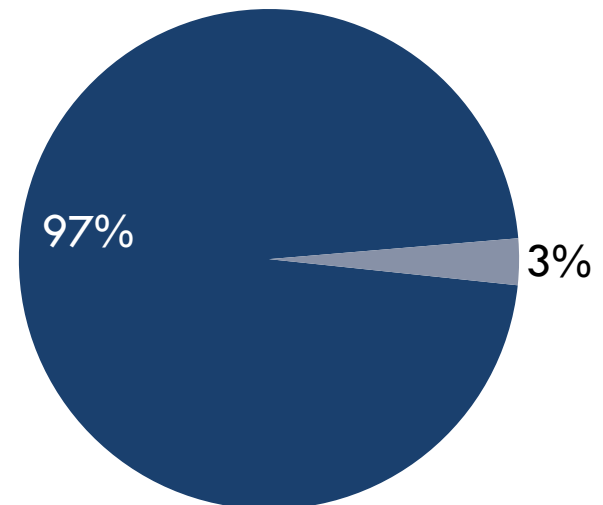
Households (HH) with Public Assistance

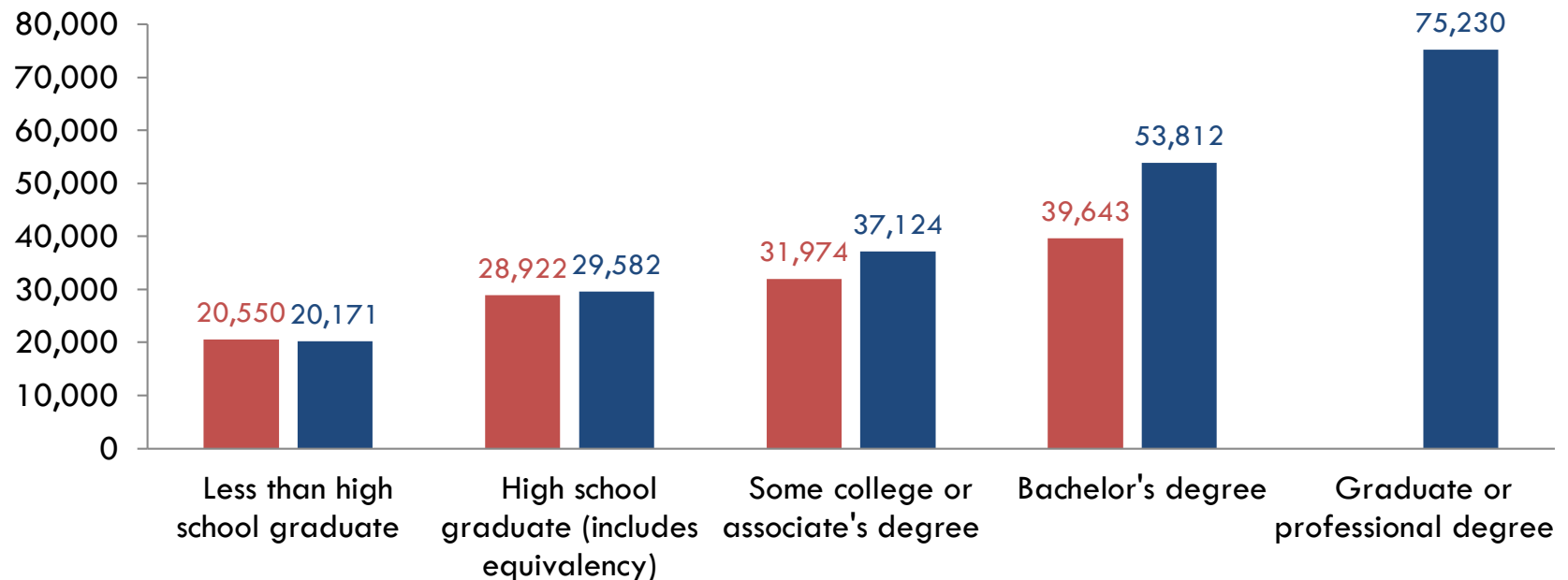

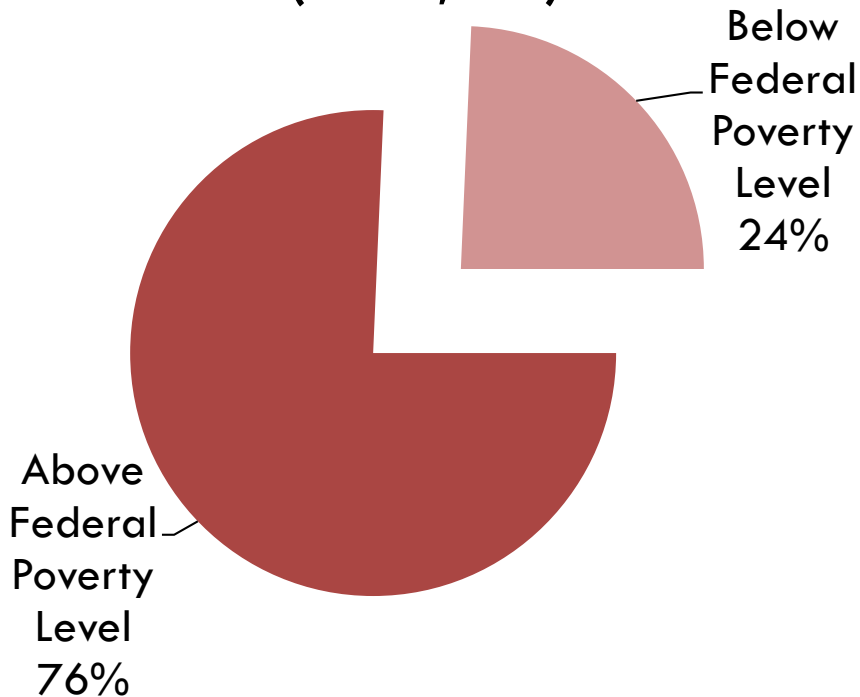

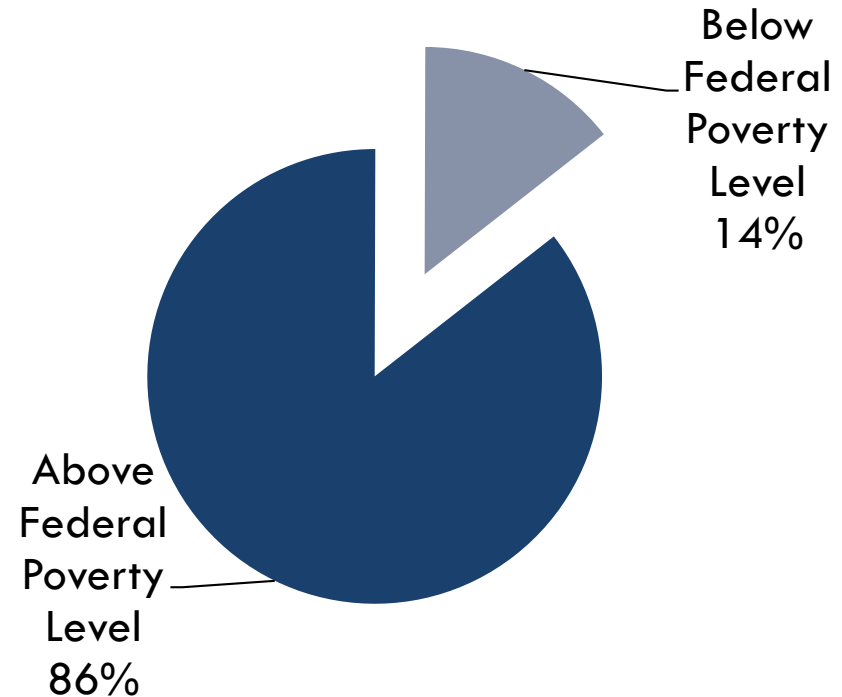

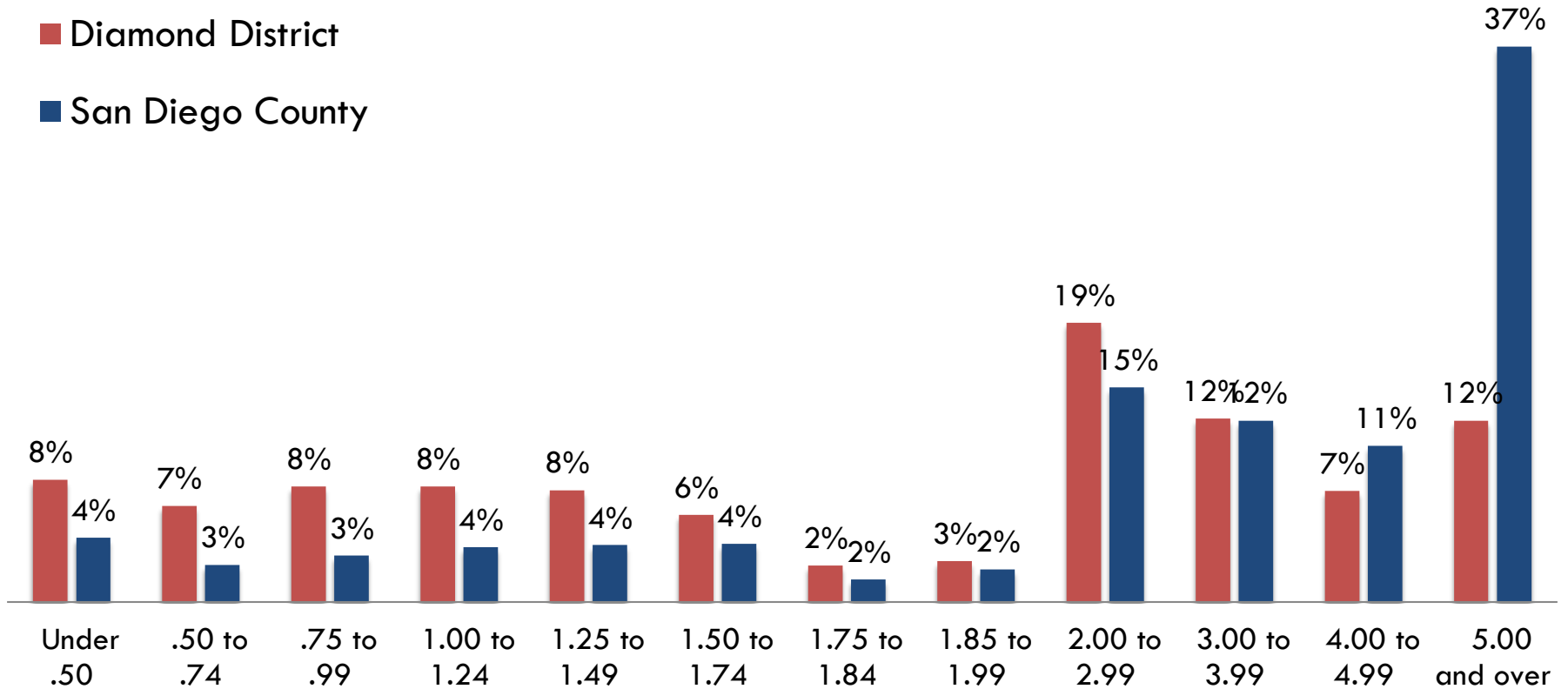

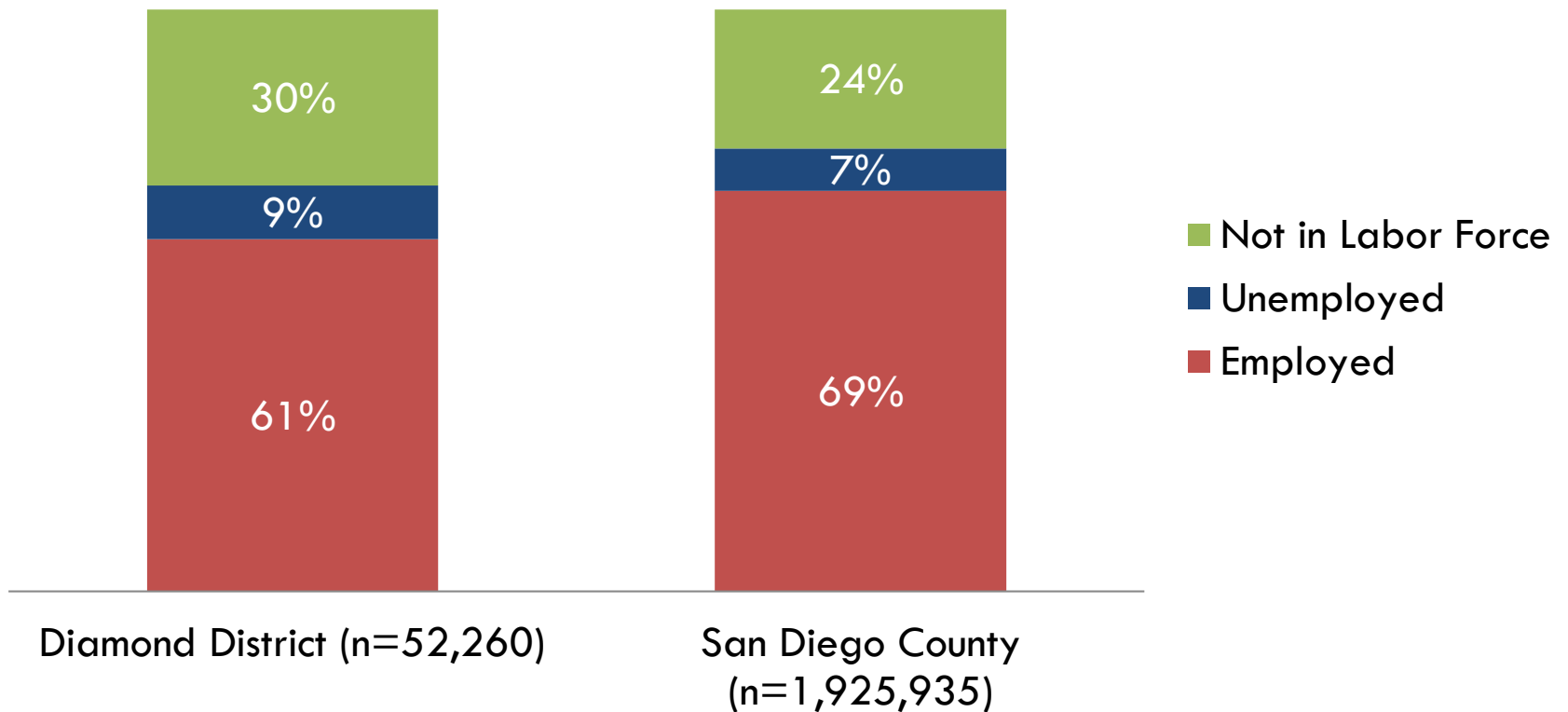
Income to Poverty Ratio in Households

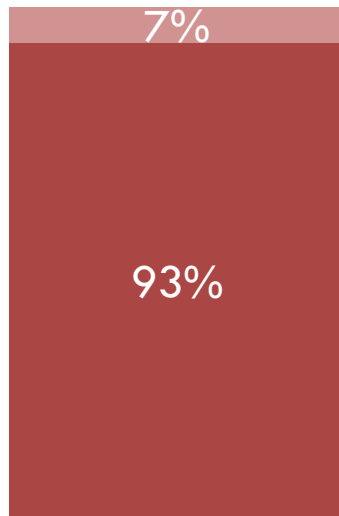

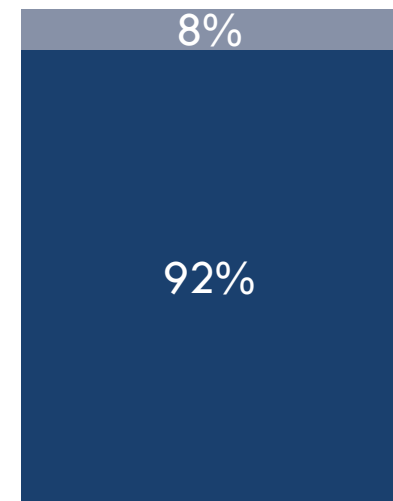

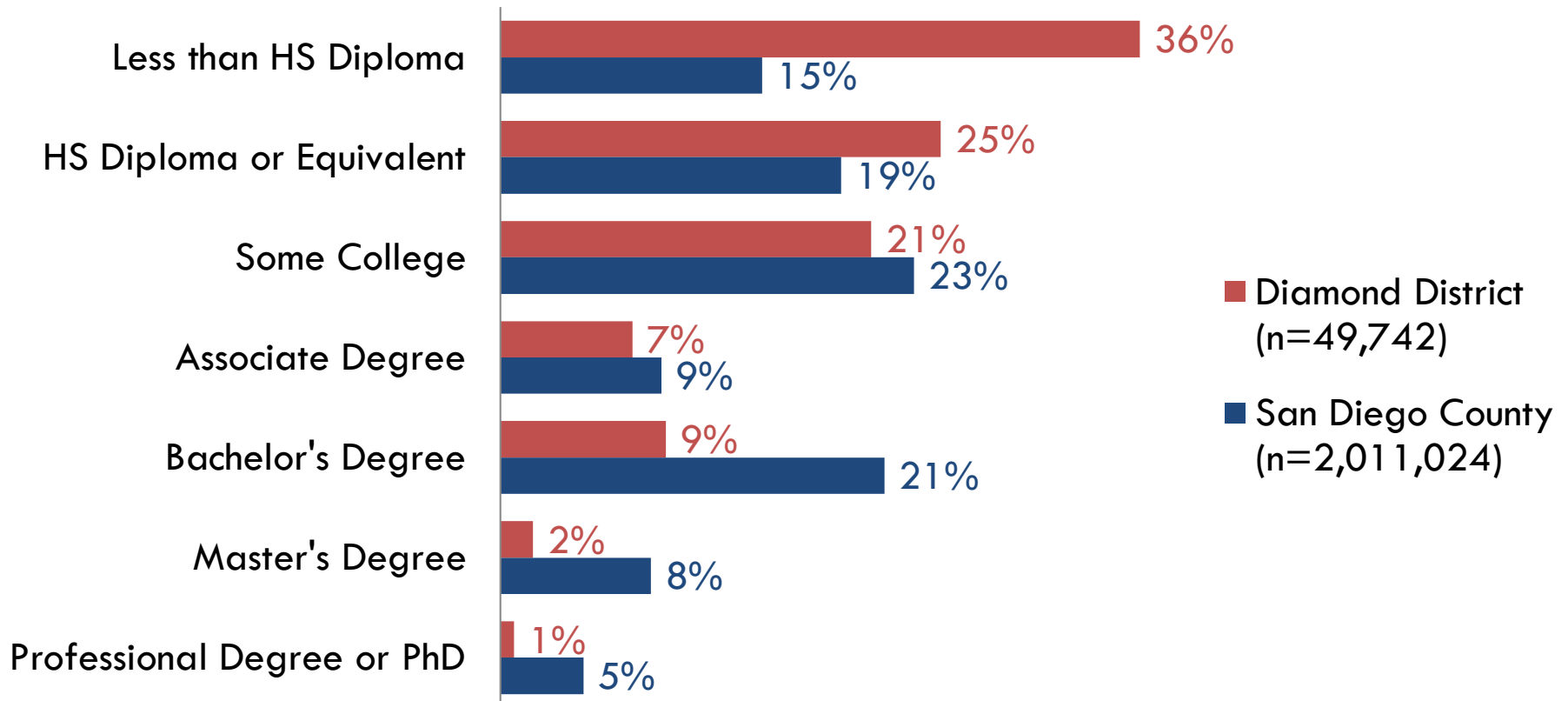

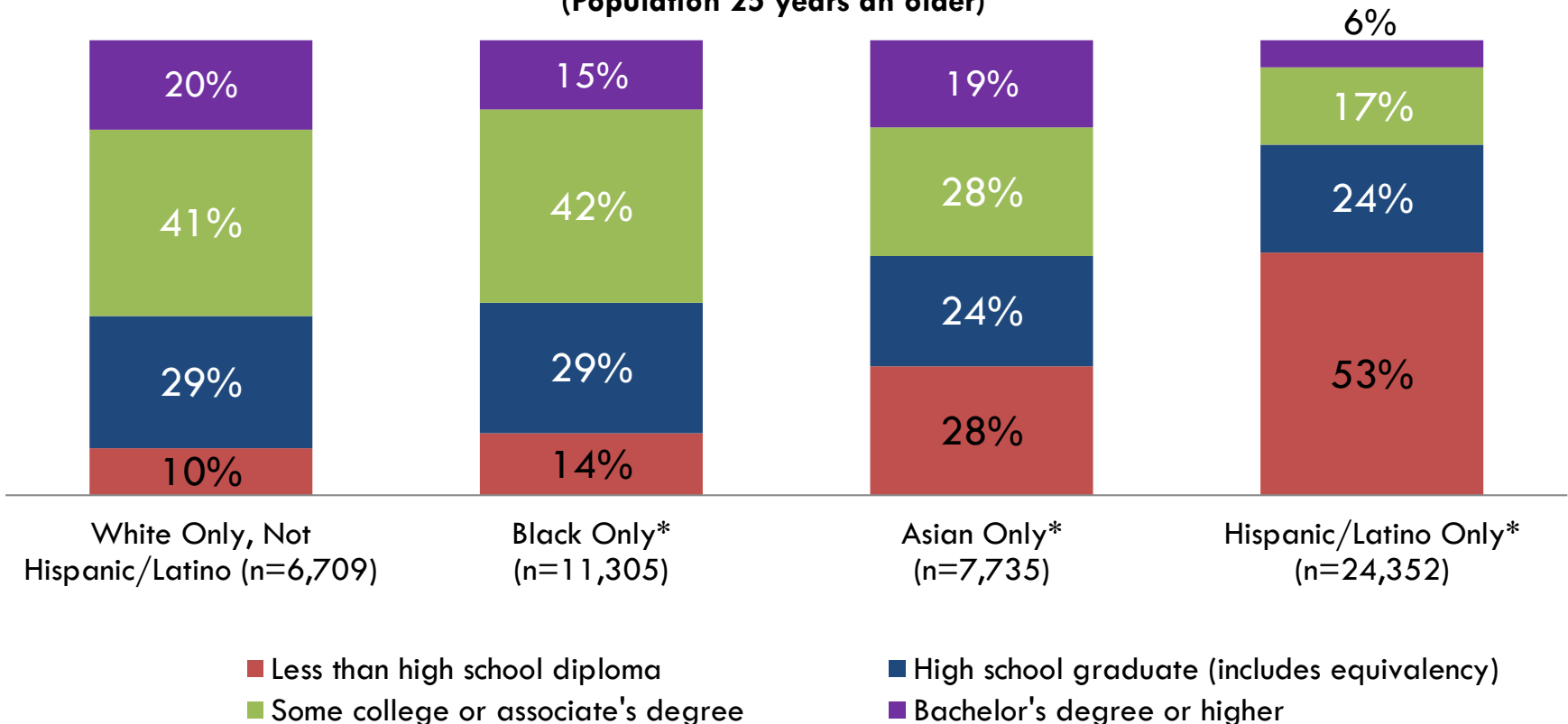
Overall Educational Attainment

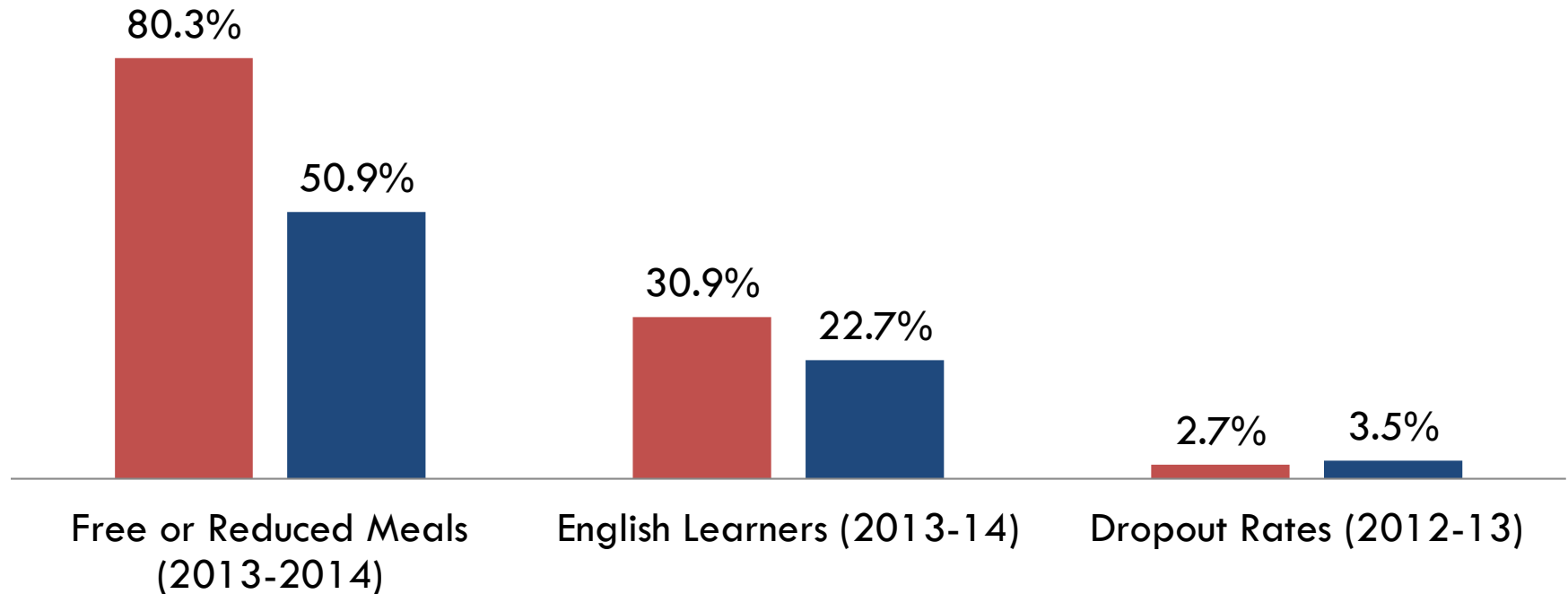

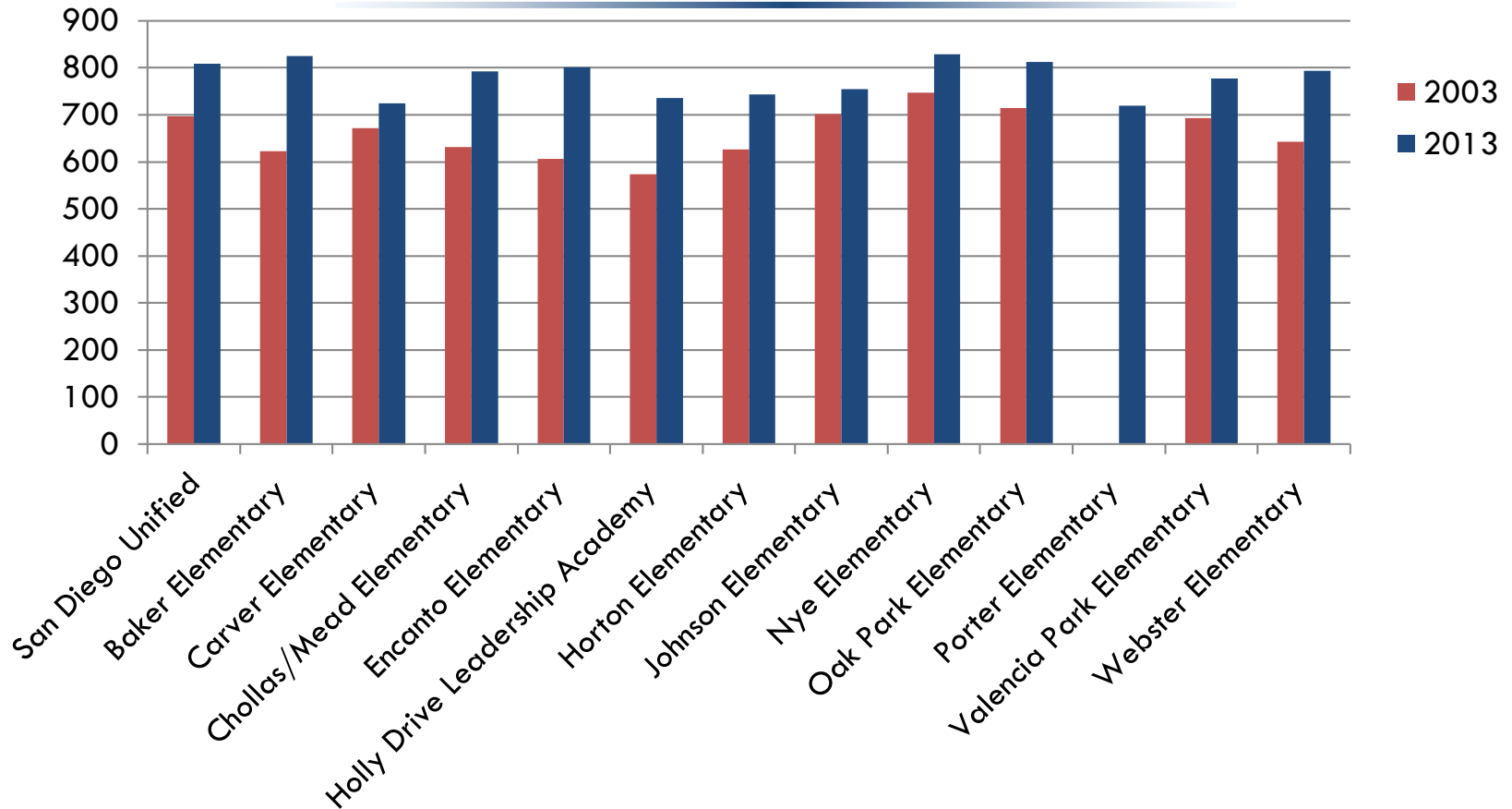
Characteristics of Students in Public Schools

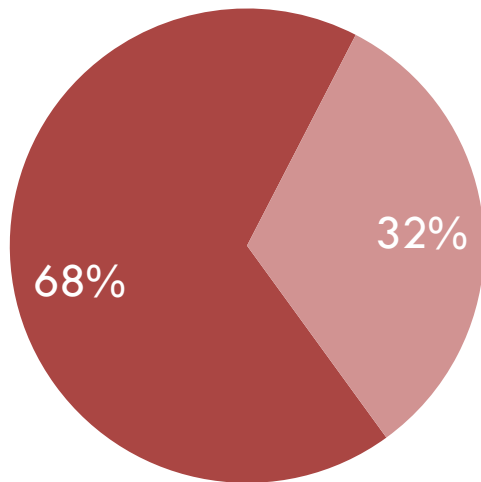
Elementary School API Scores – 10 Year Change

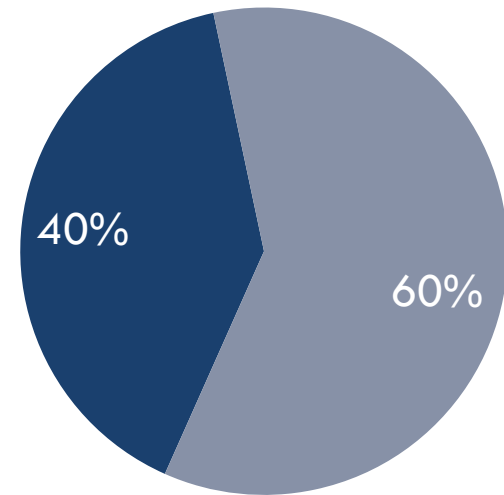
Percent of 12th Grade Students Taking the SAT

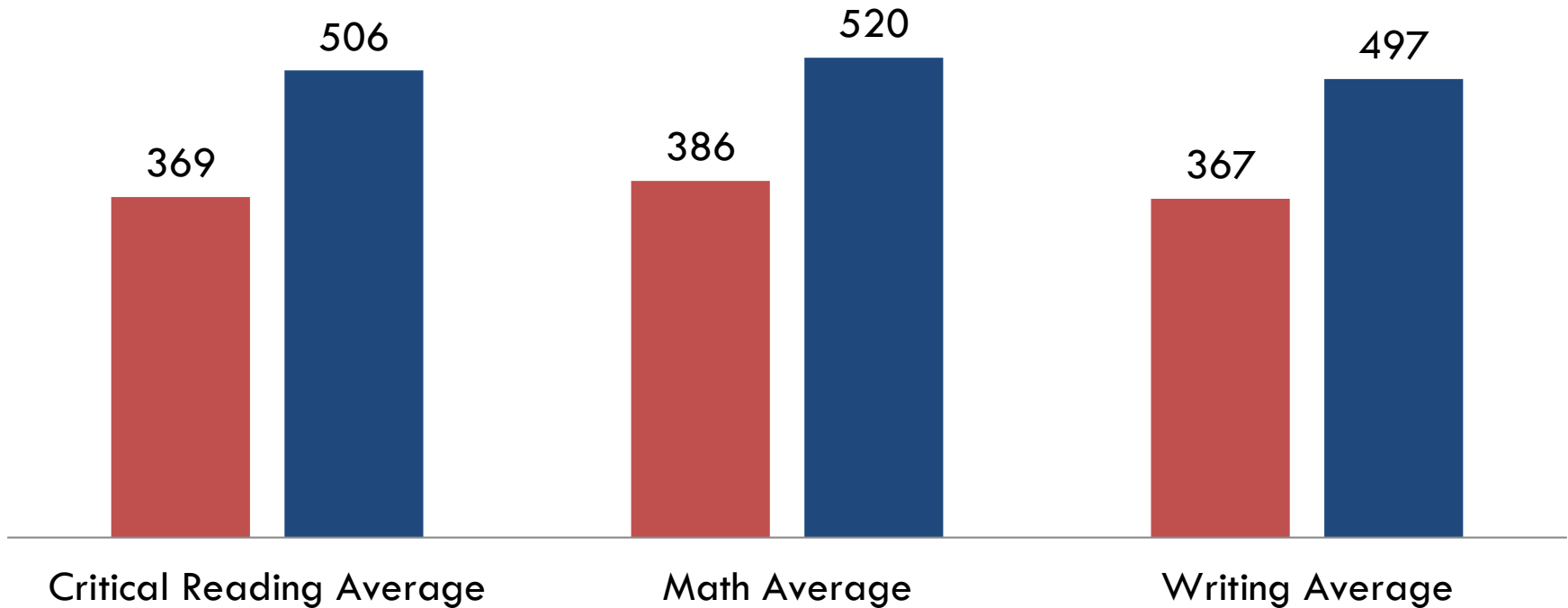

SAT Scores: 2012-2013

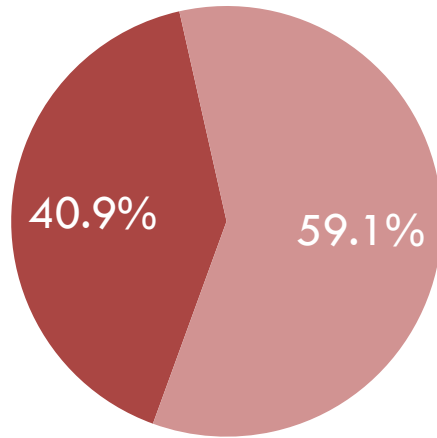

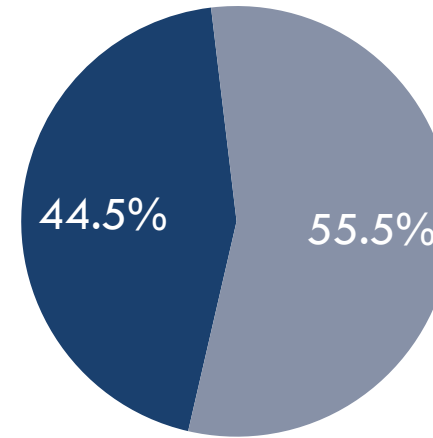
Percent of Resident vs Incoming Students (2013-14)

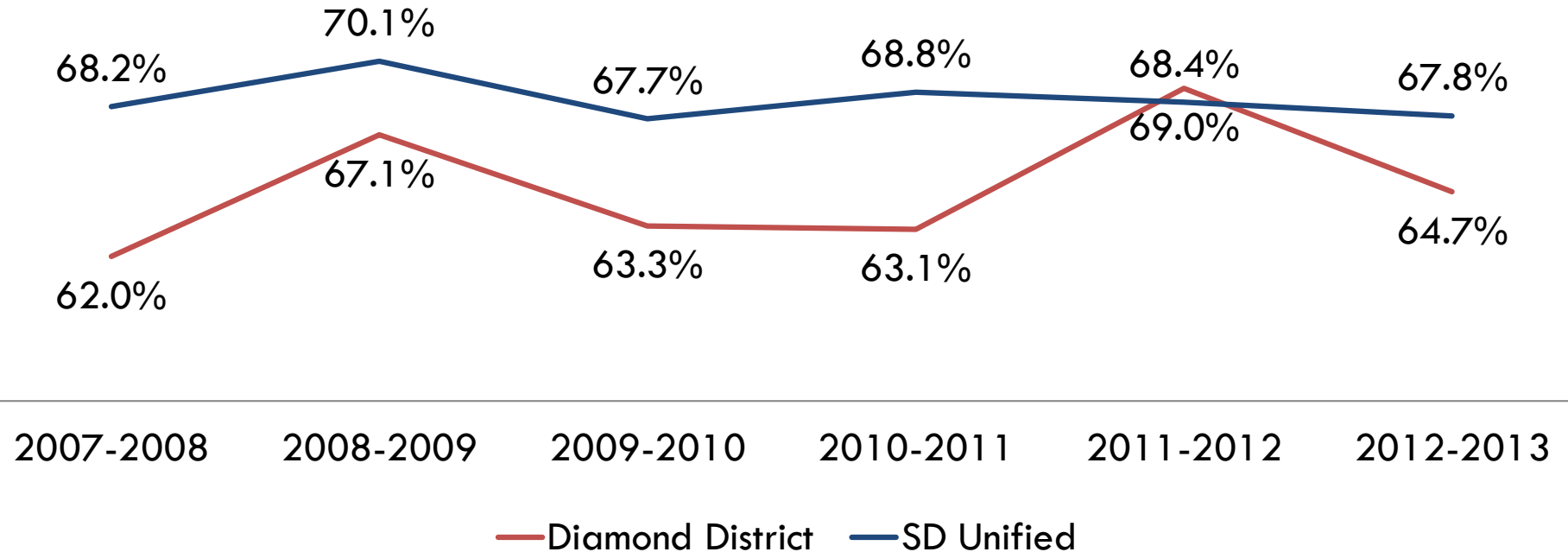

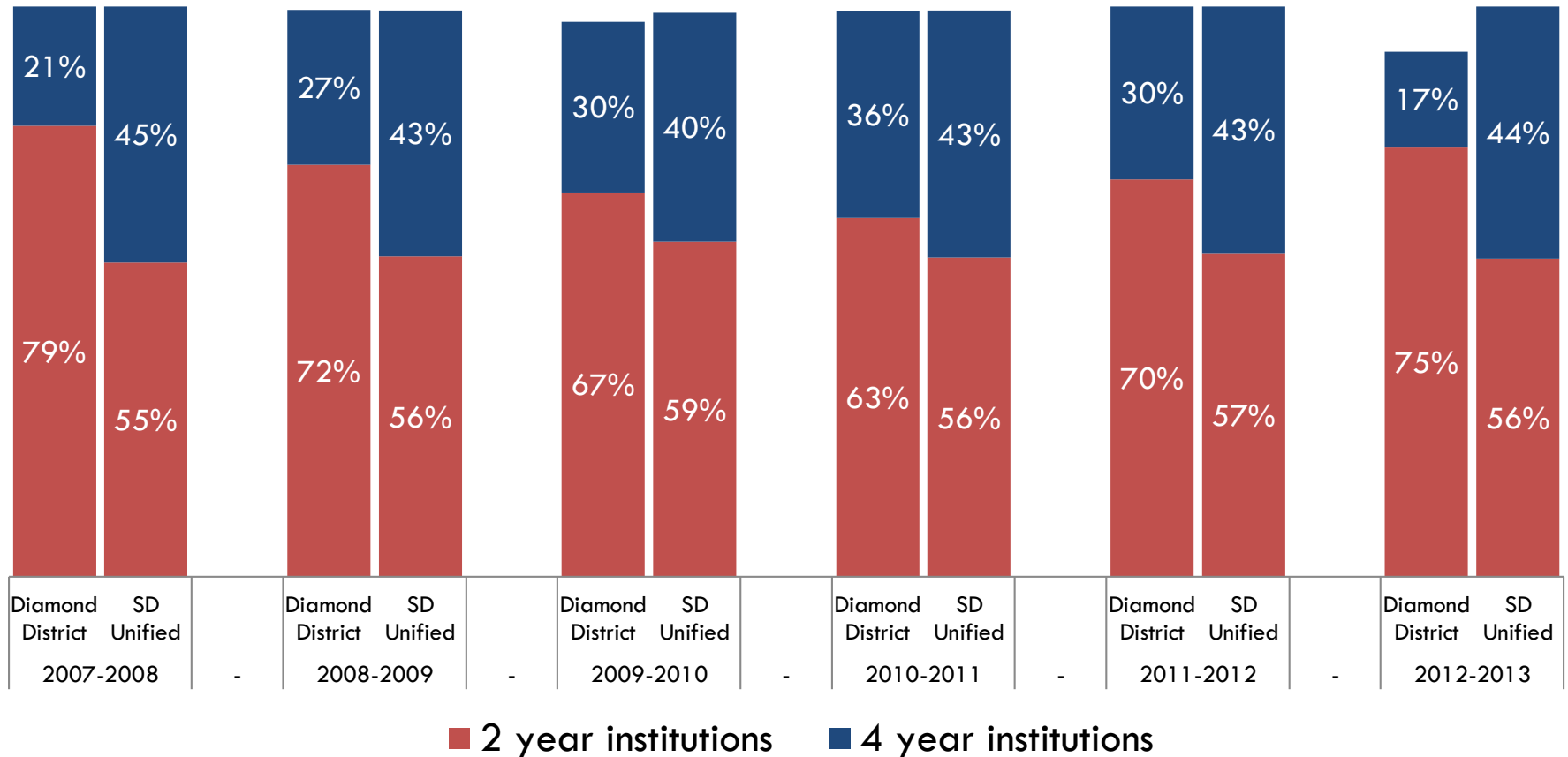

Graduates with Postsecondary Enrollment 1-Year Post Graduation



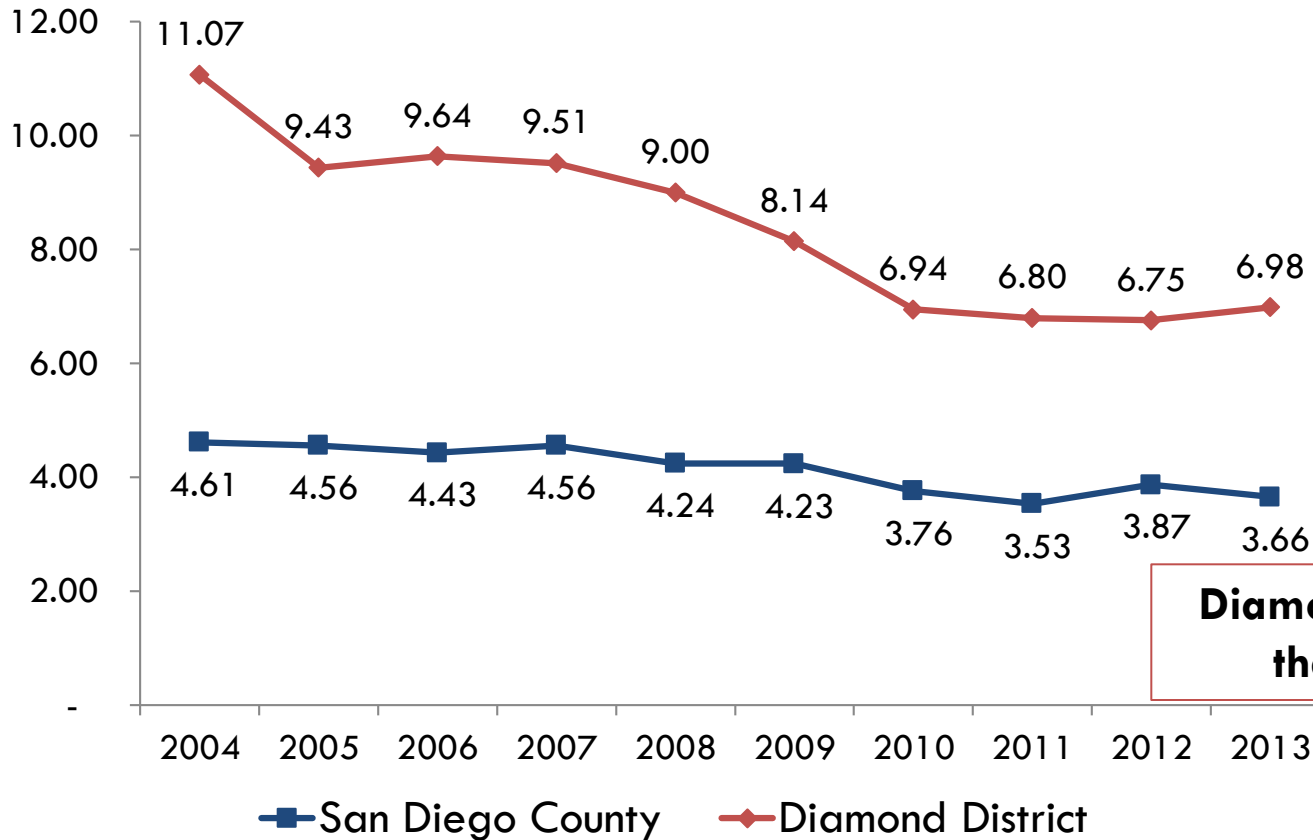

Violent Crime (per 1,000 population)



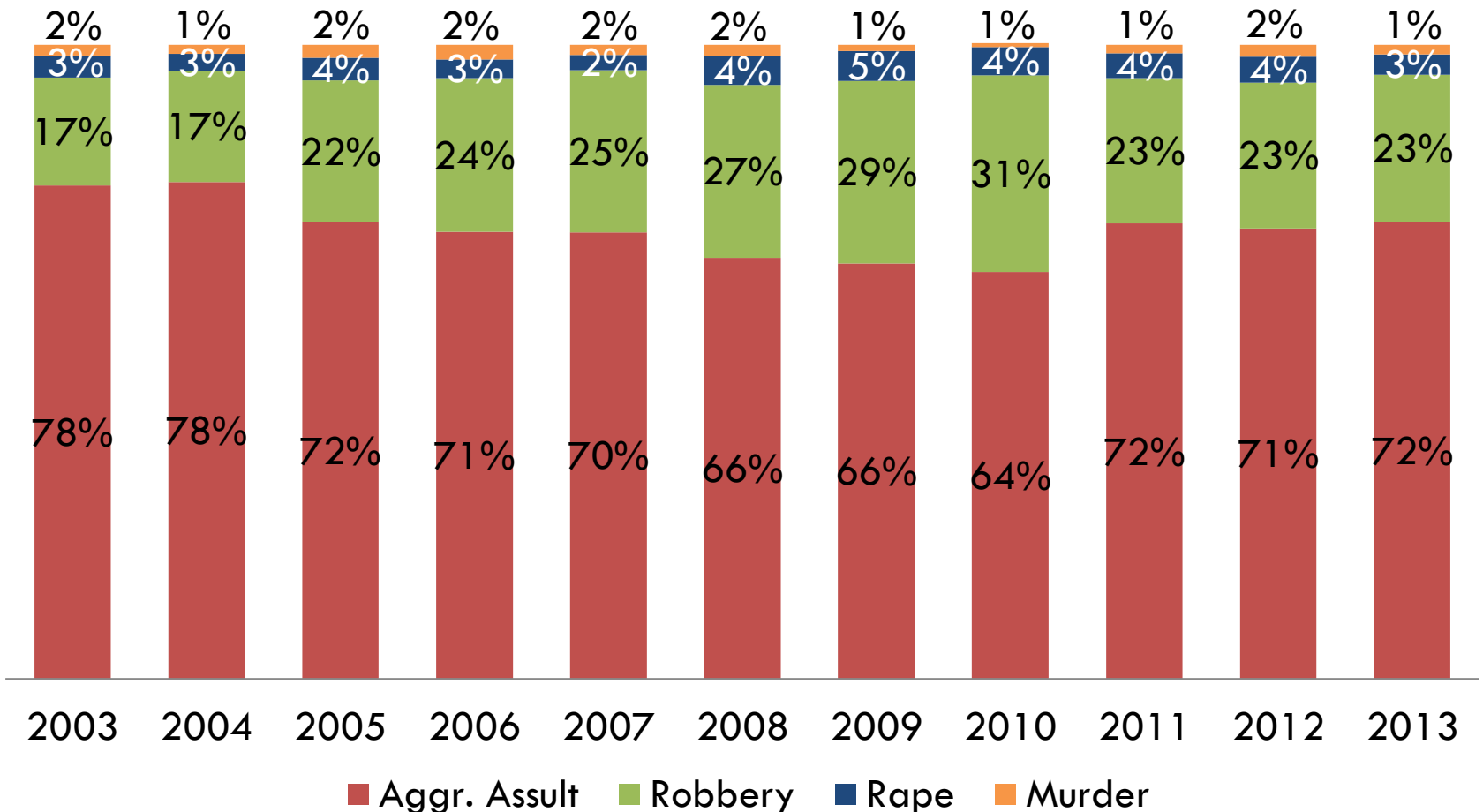

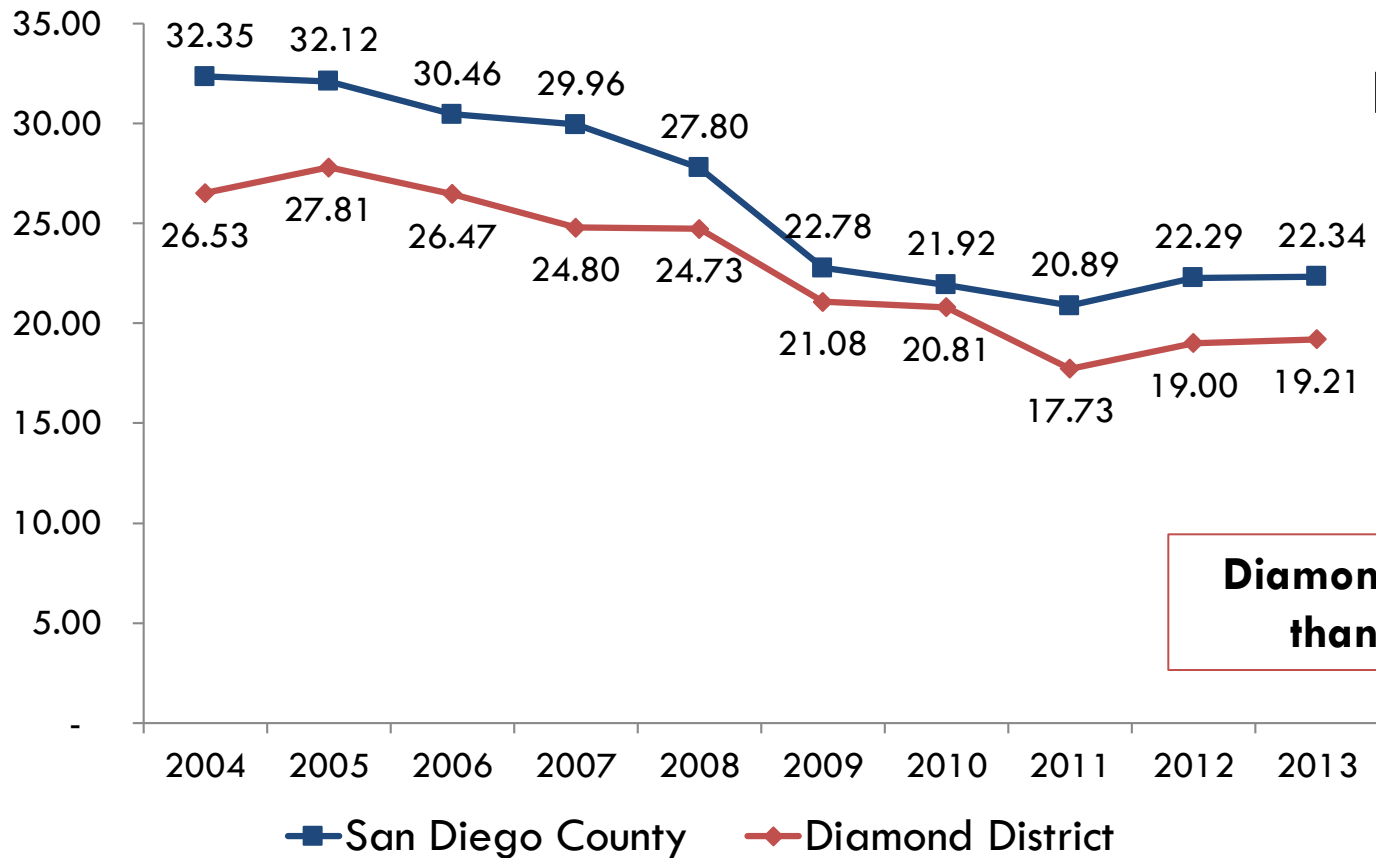

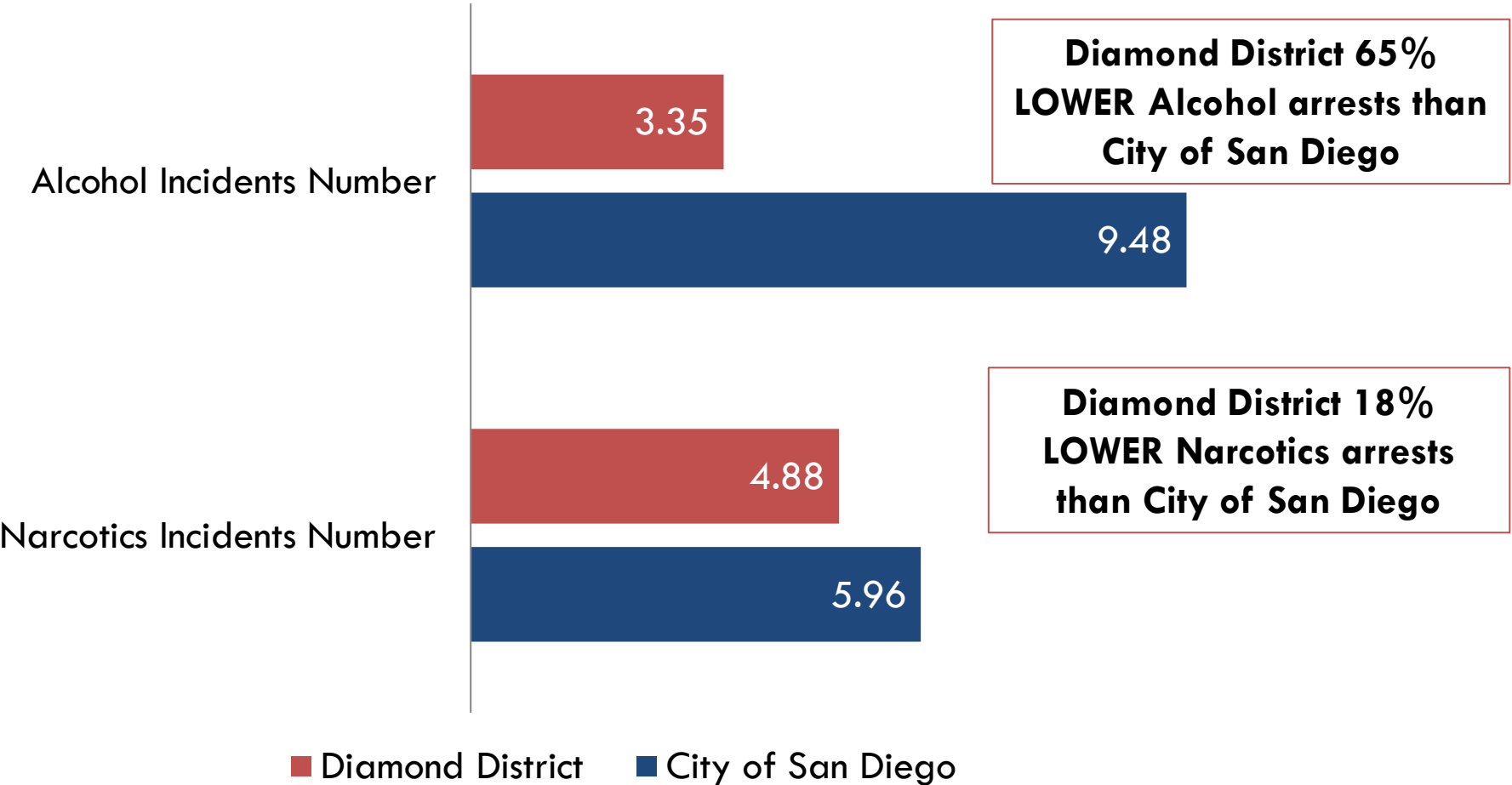

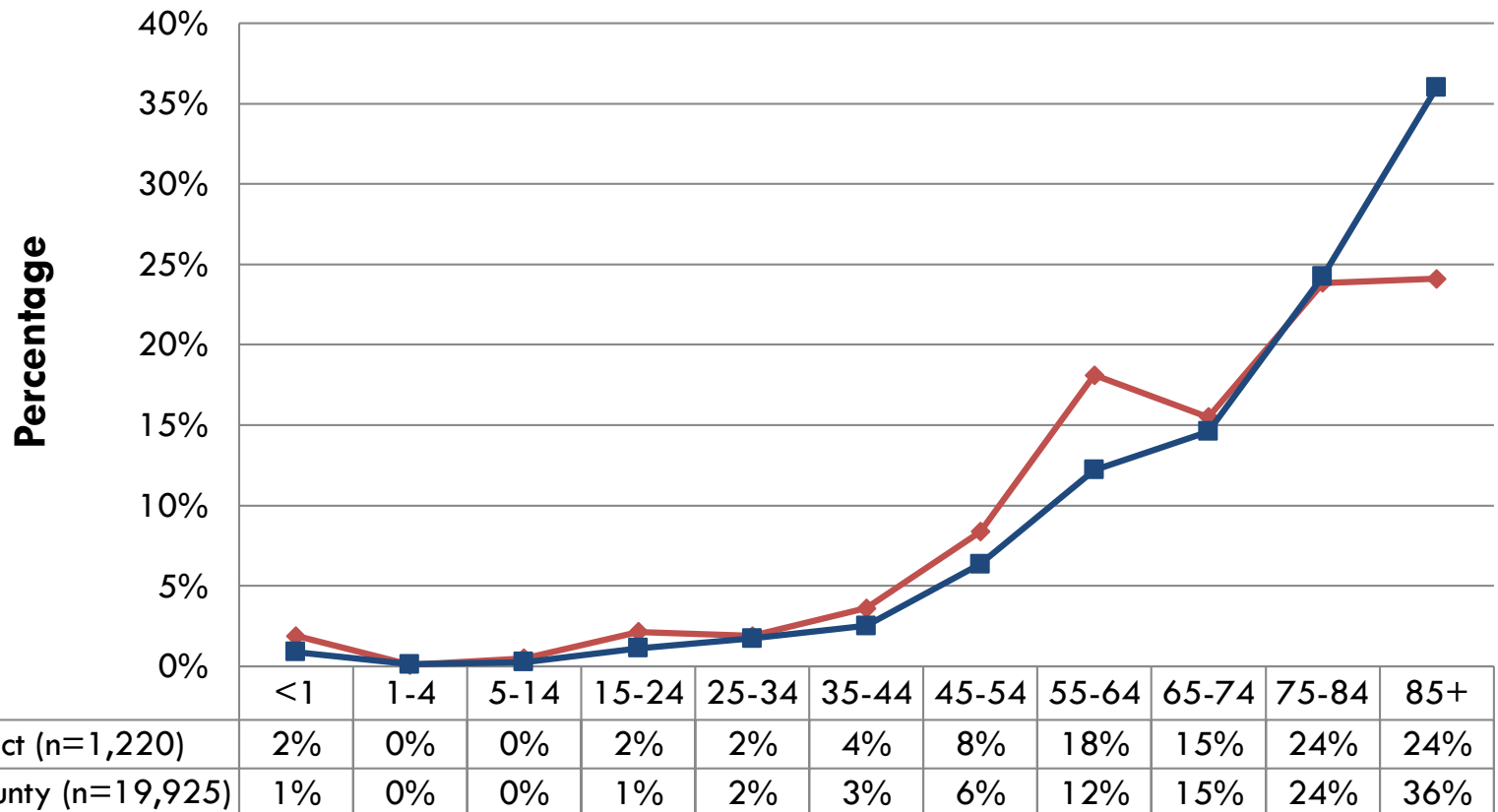

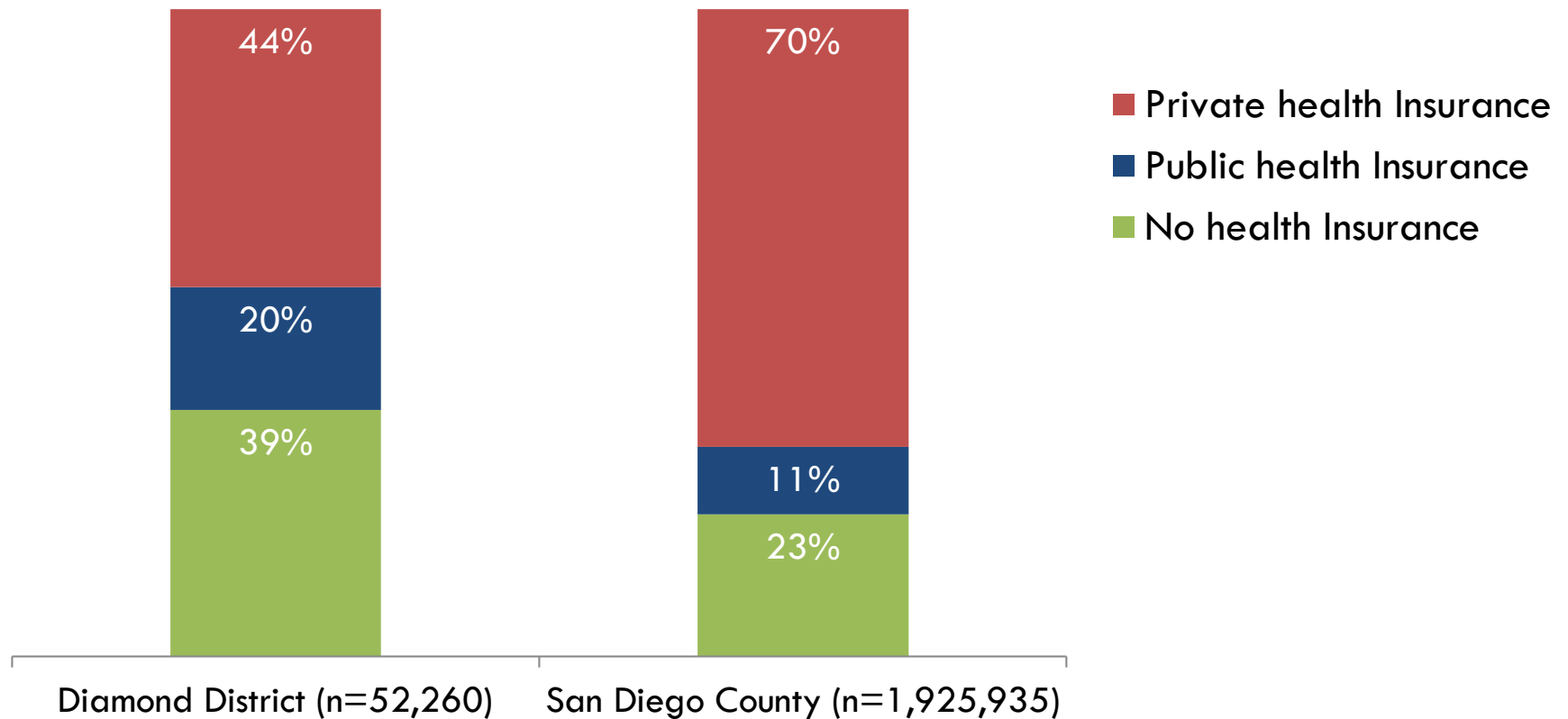

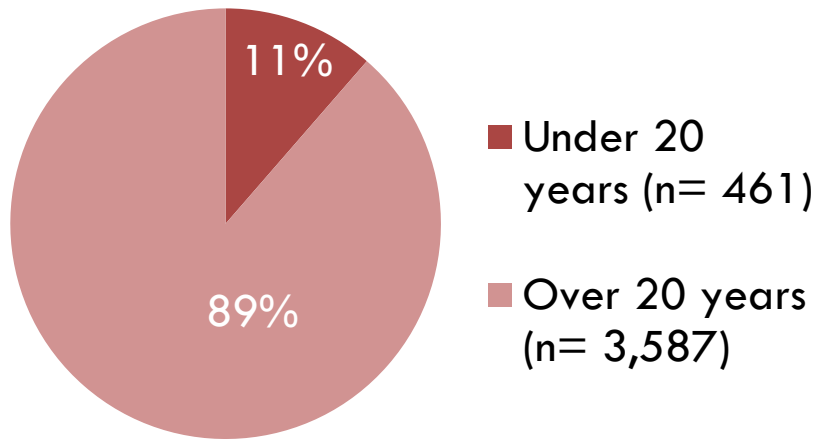
Health Insurance Coverage by Source



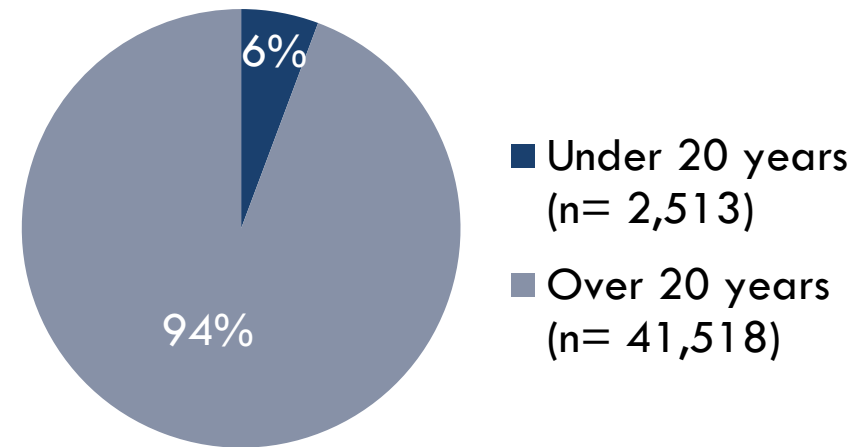

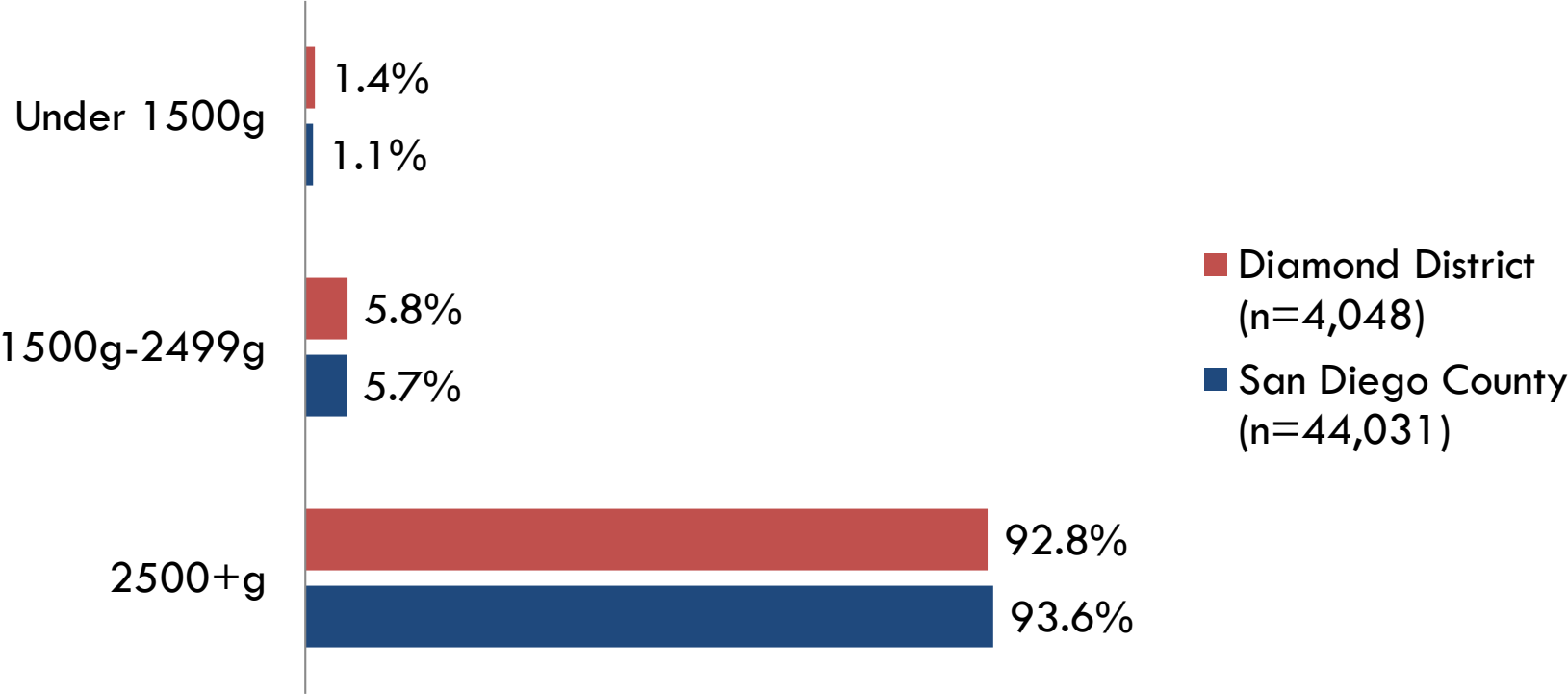

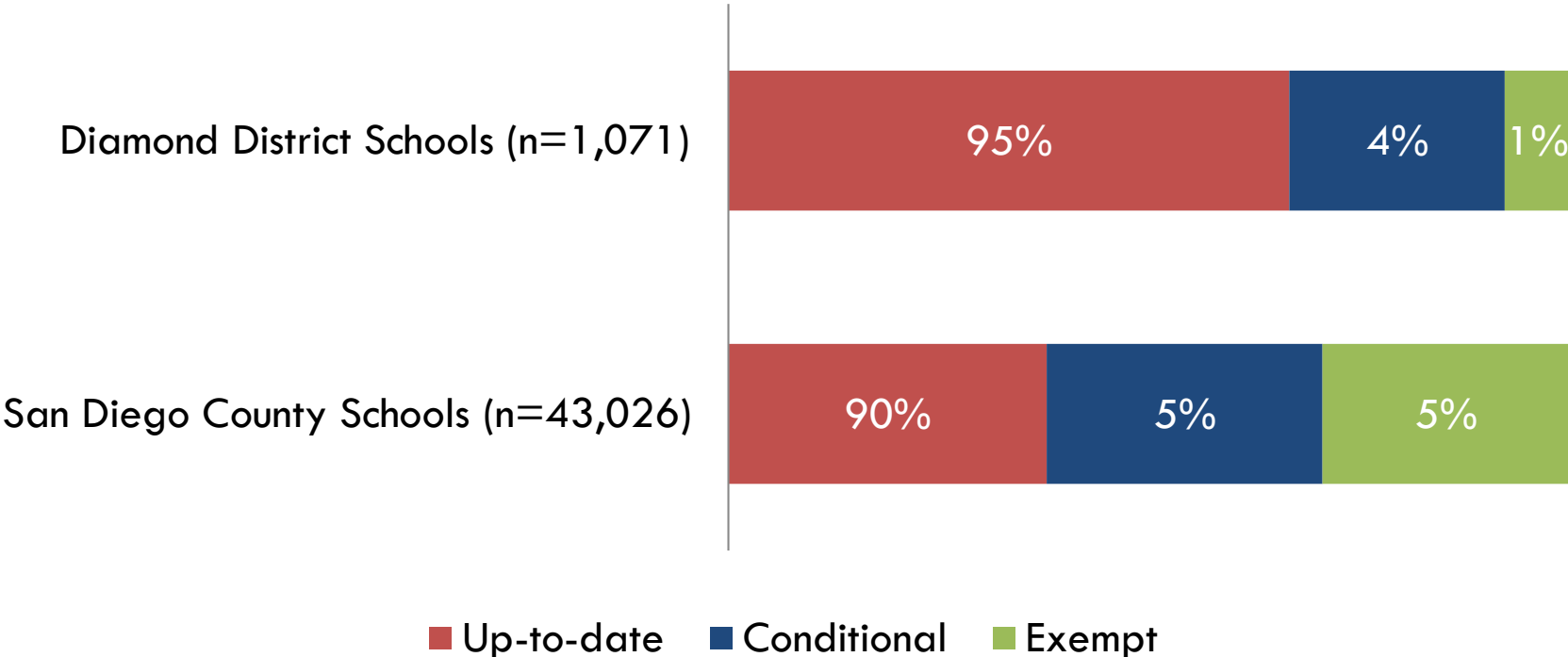

Birth Weight



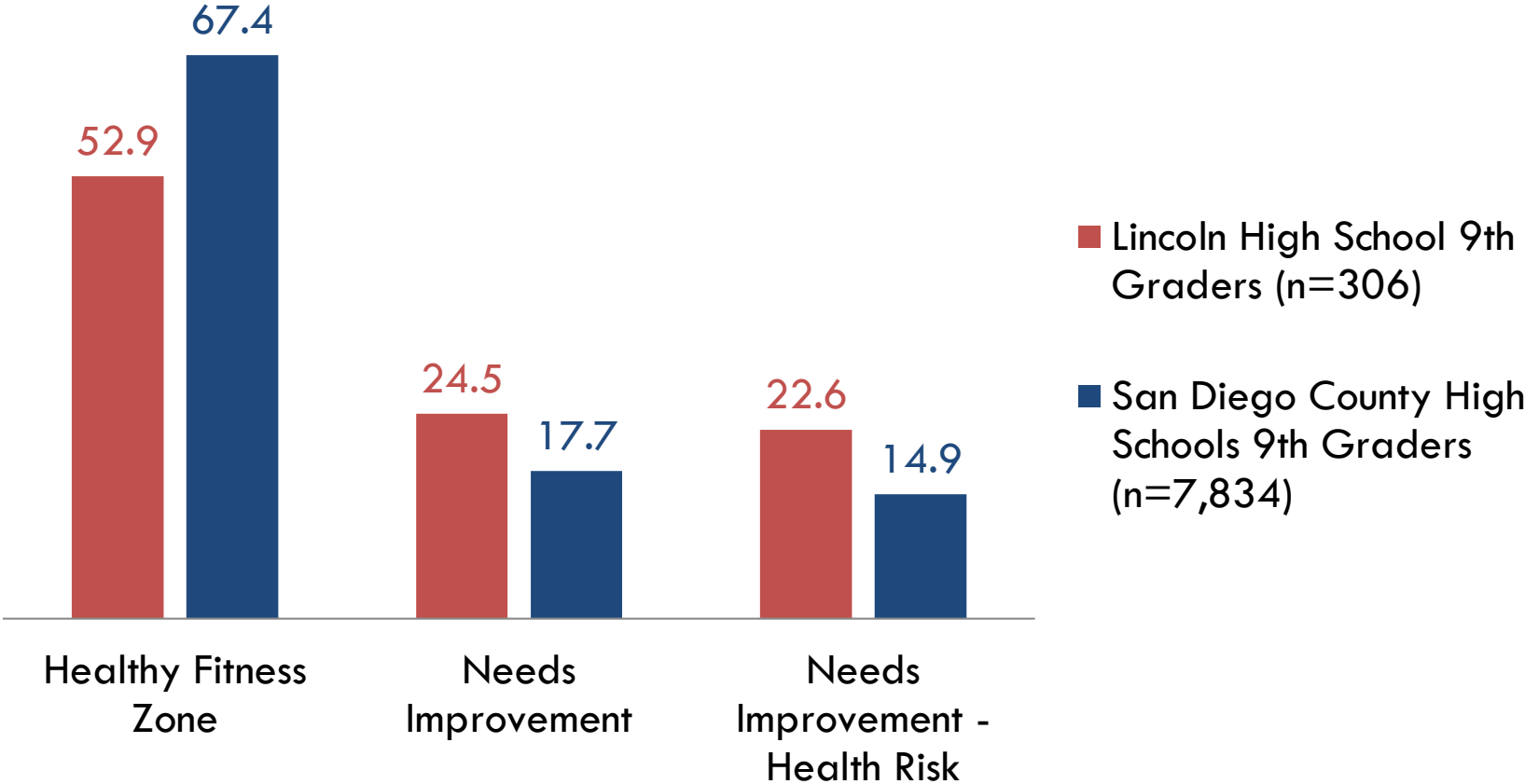

Immunization Status of Kindergarten Students



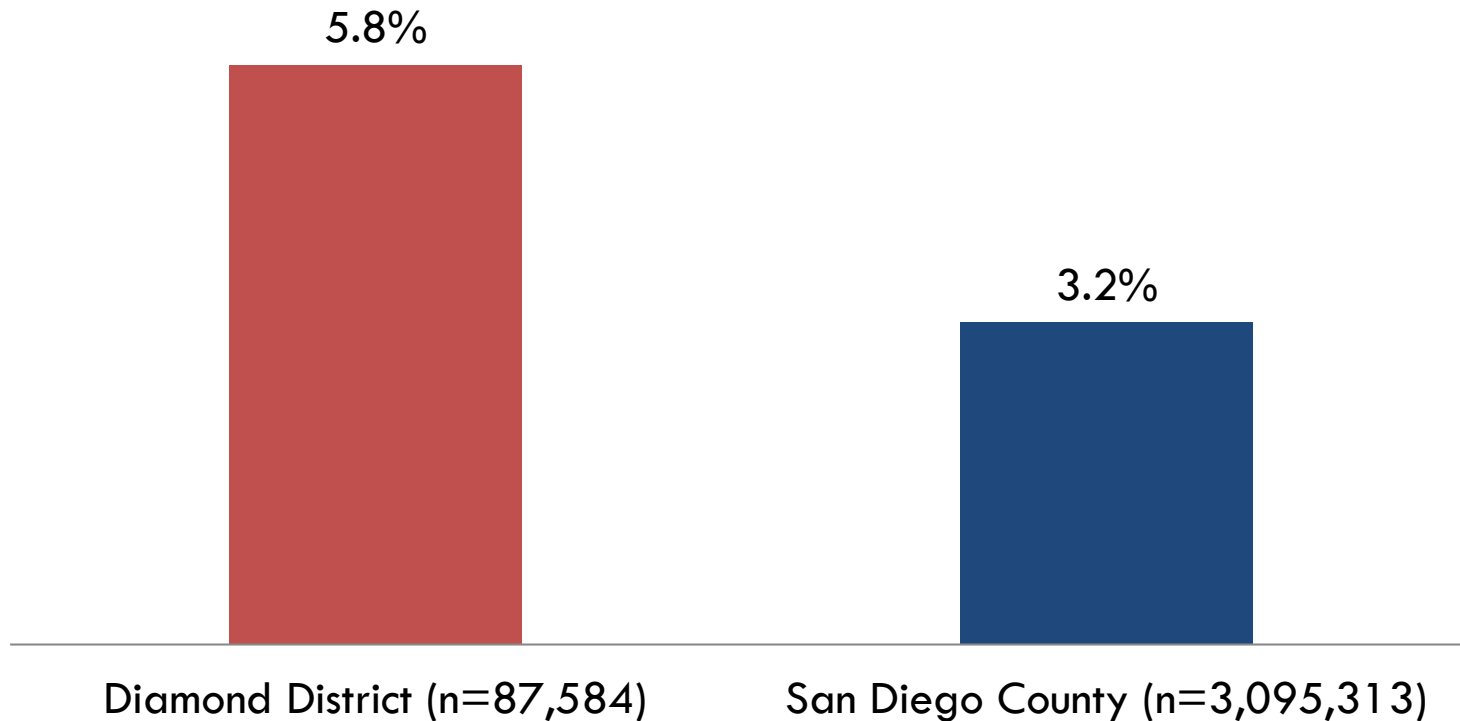

Body Composition of 9th Graders



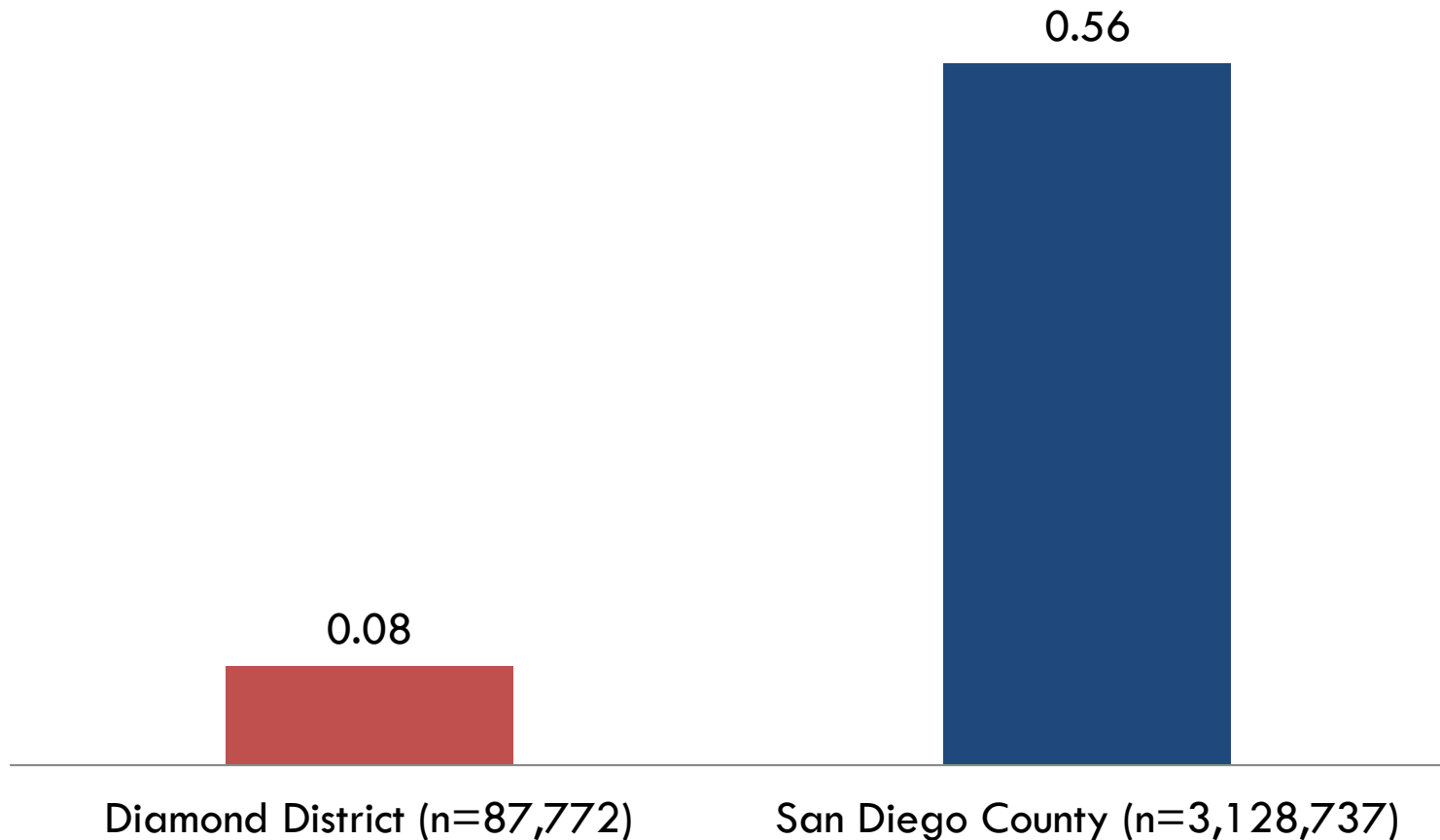

Percent of Population Residing more than 1 mile from Grocery Store



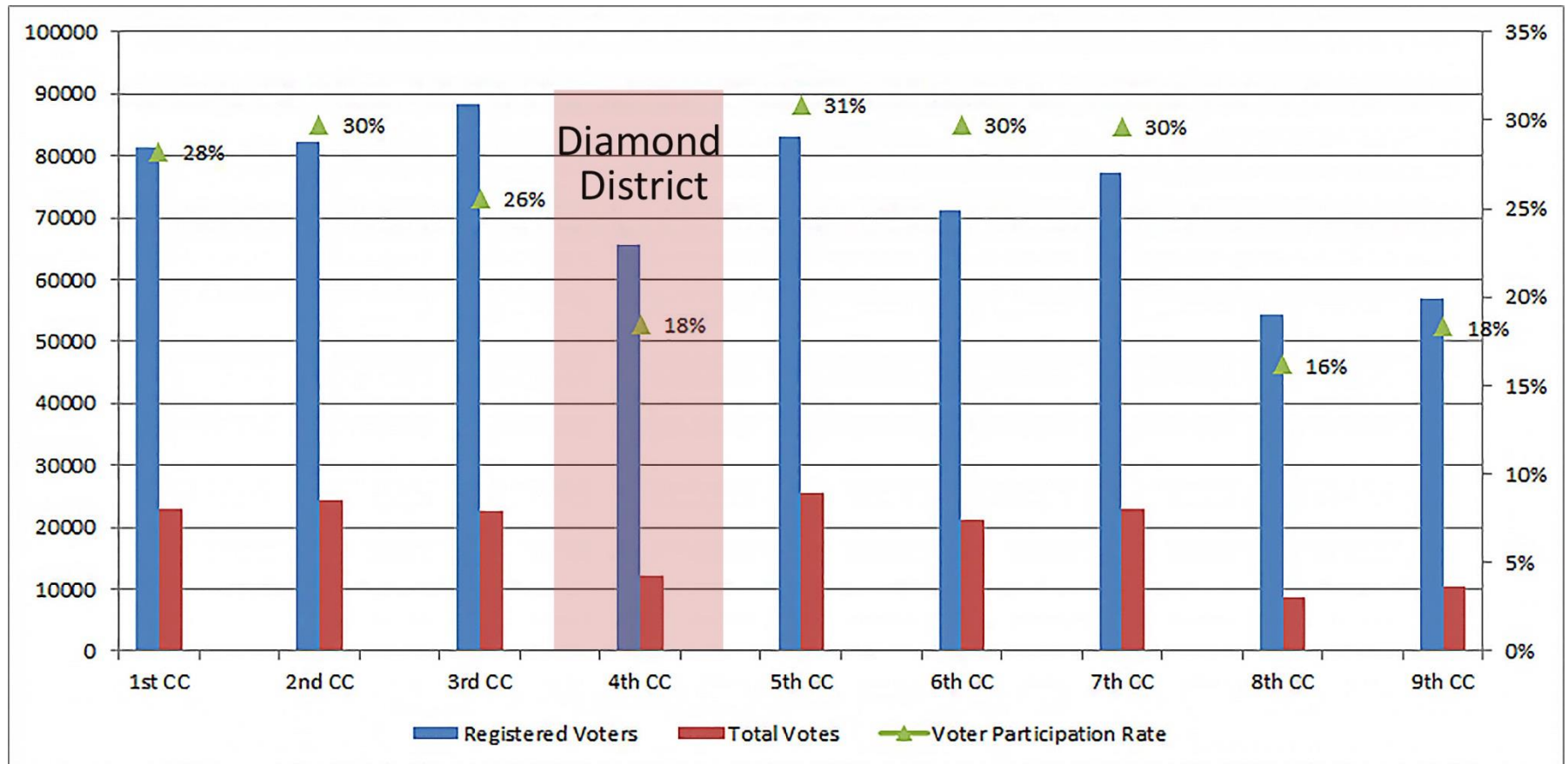

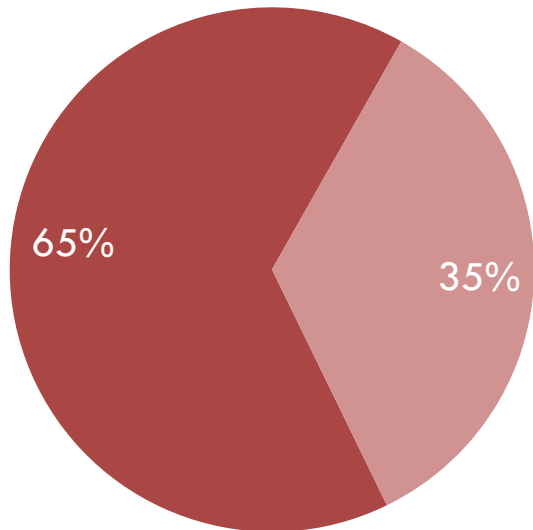
Voter Participation in June 2014 Special Election by City Council (CC) Districts

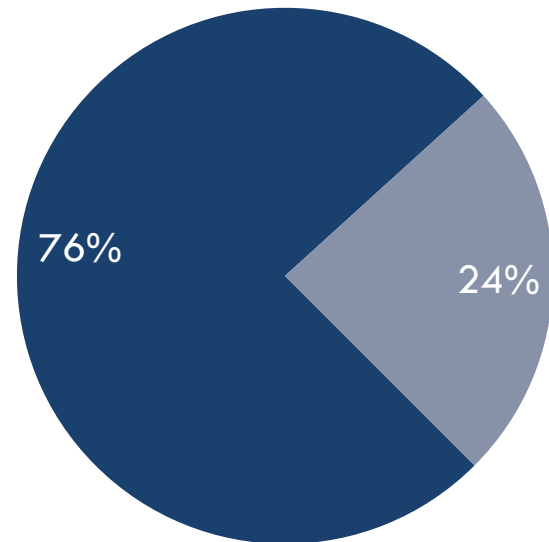

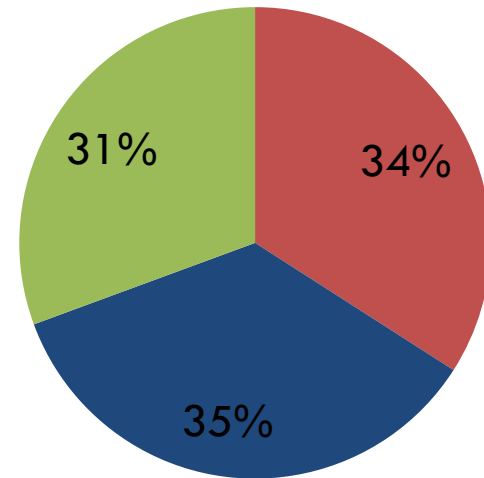

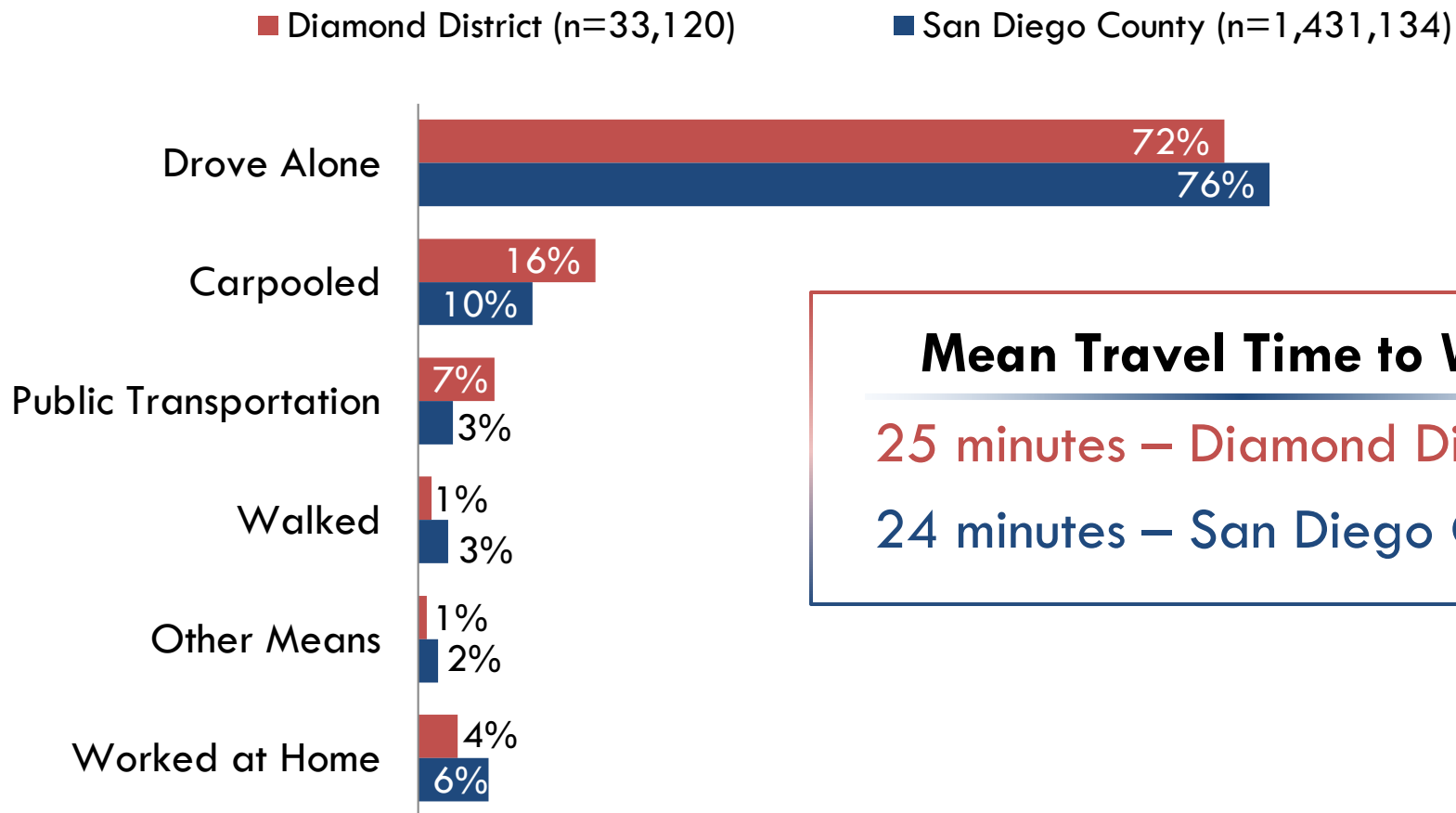

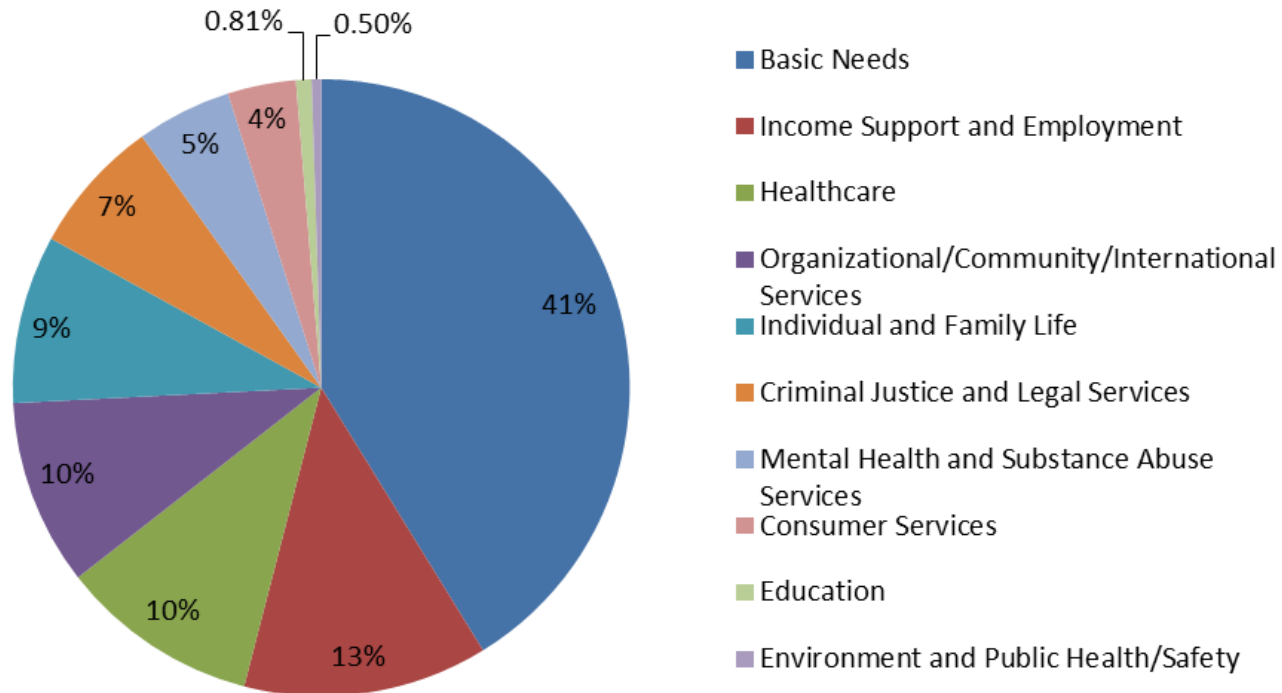

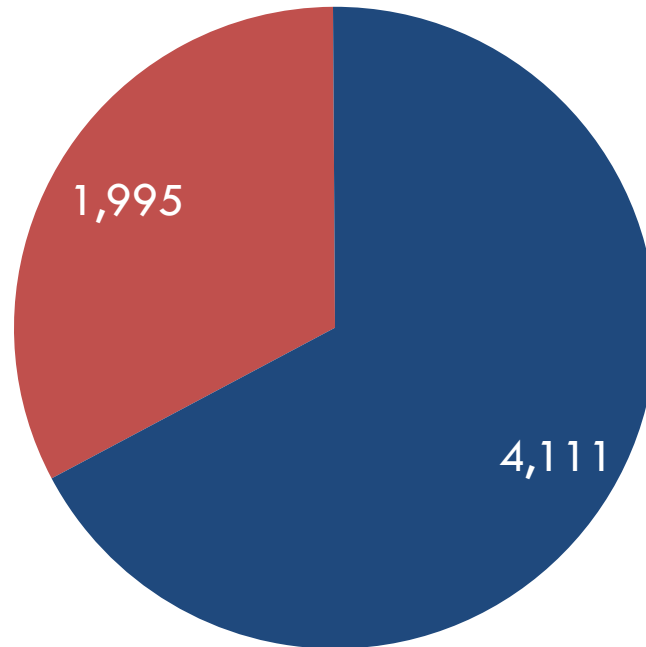

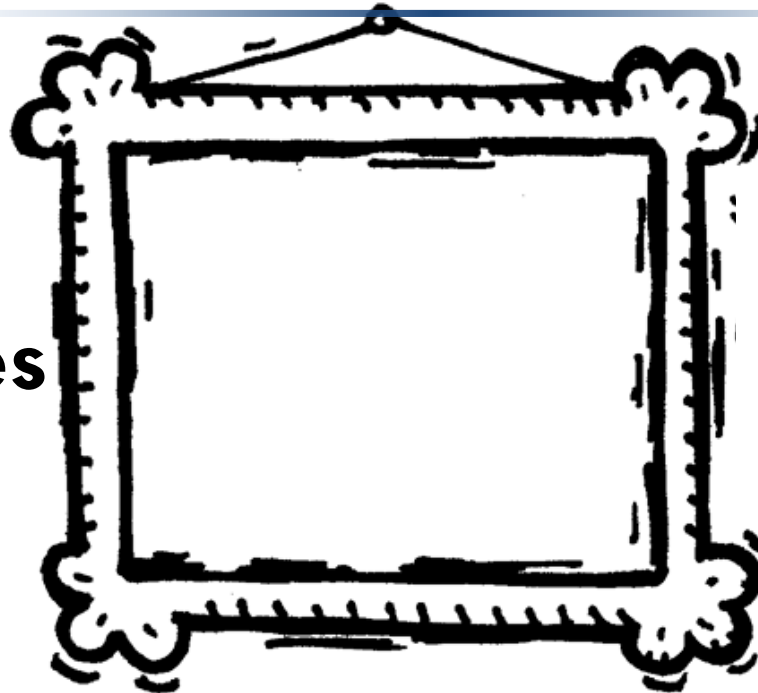

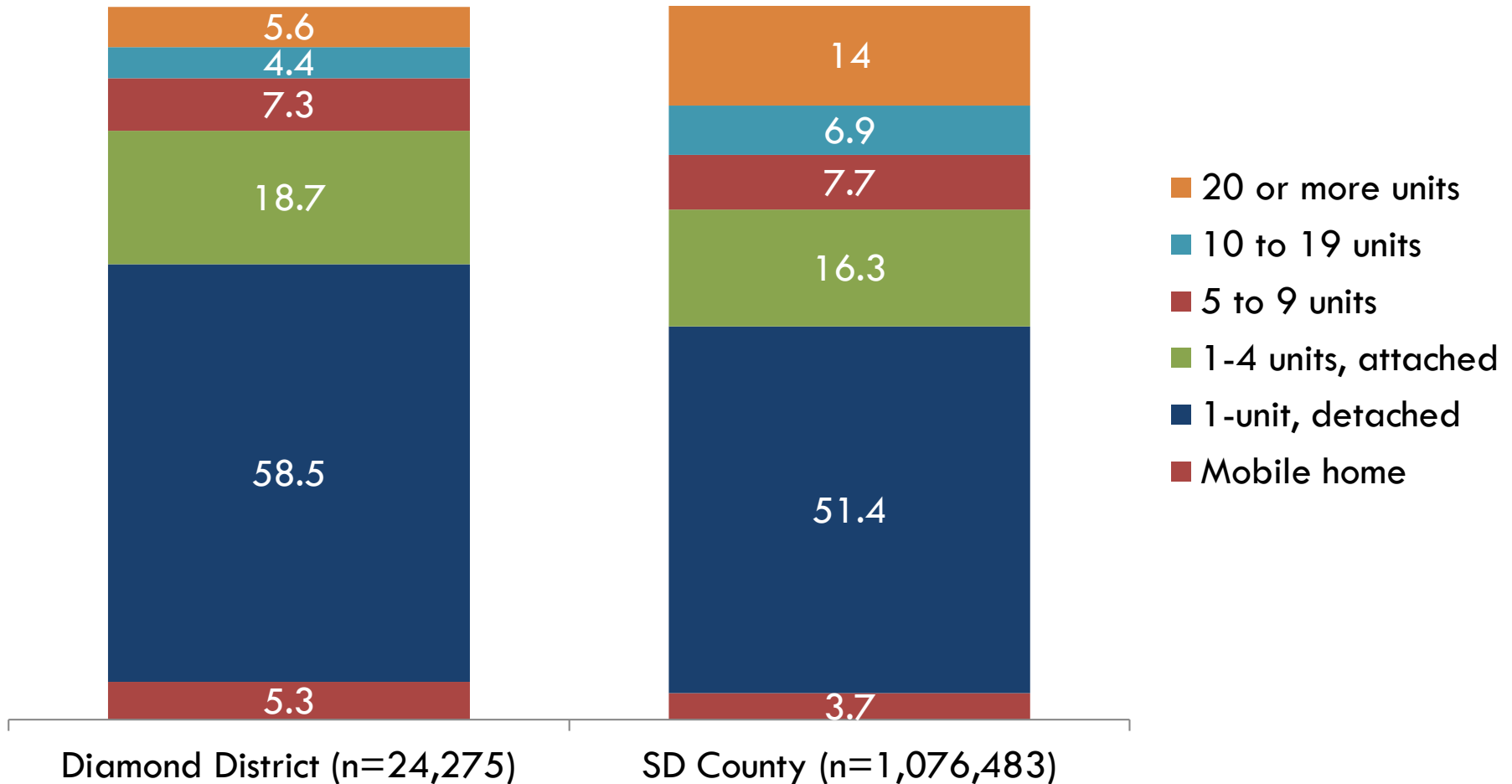

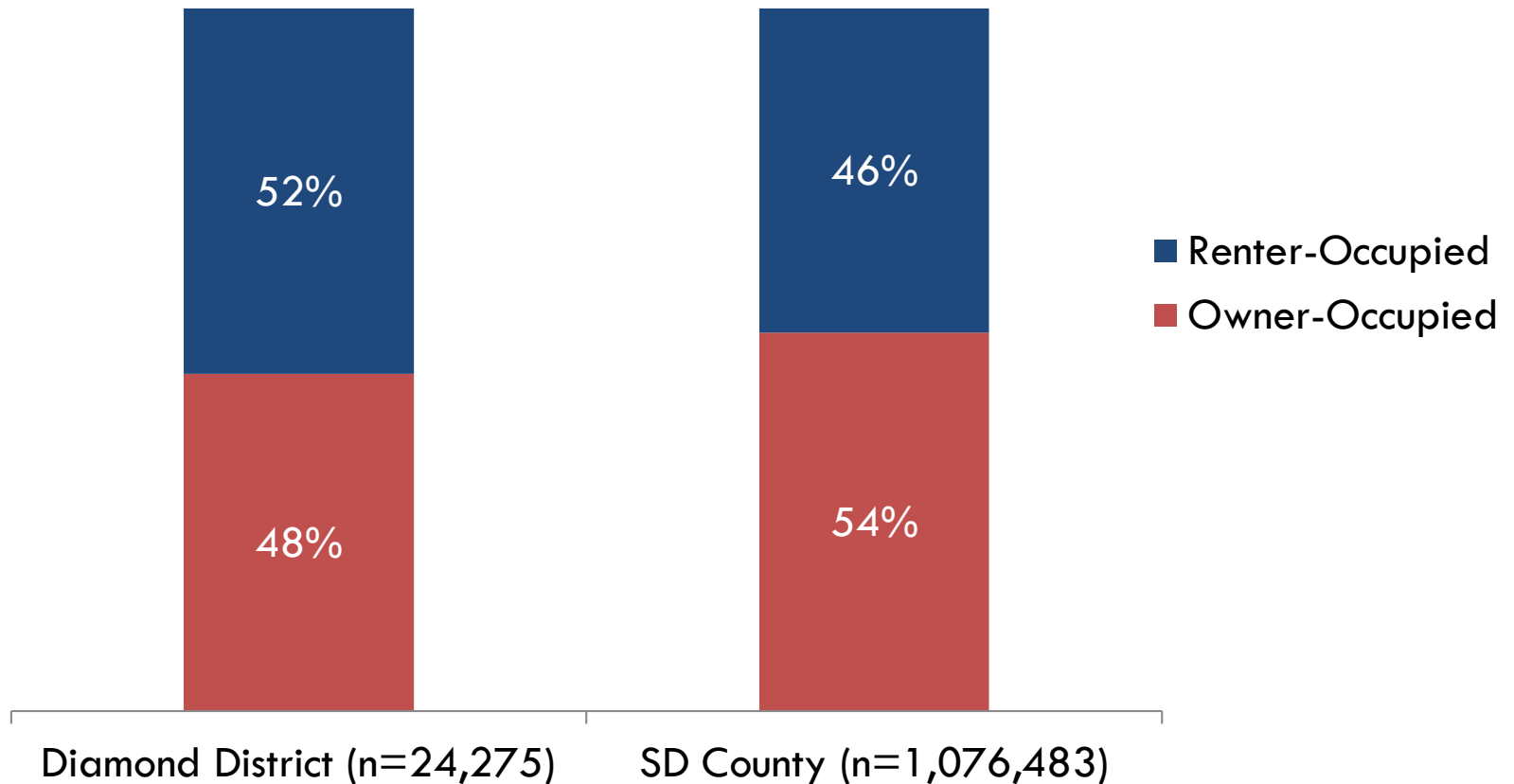
Character of Physical Environment

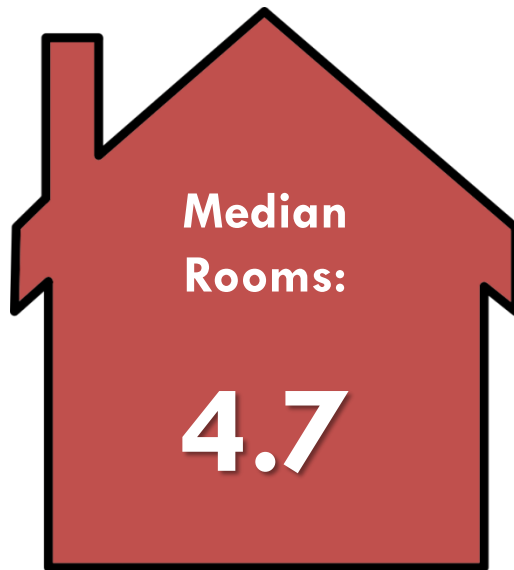

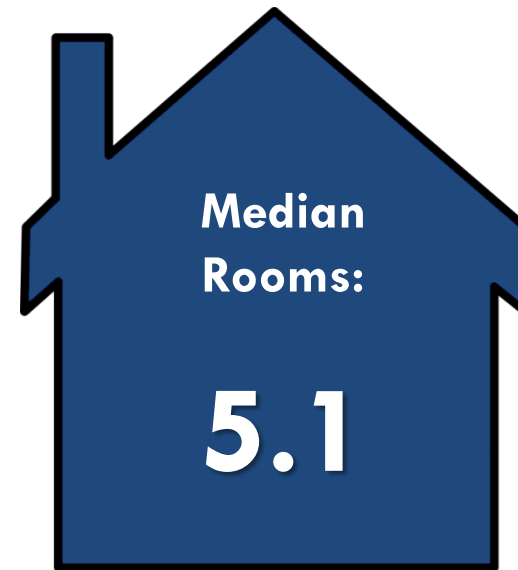
